


#### MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market was hit hard and finished the day near the lows as the currency fell below 66 cents. US market was negative and then Fitch downgraded US long term debt from AAA to AA+. The question is not why the US should be downgraded. It is why now? The US has \$32trill debt at government level that needs \$1trill interest payment per year while the government deficits are expected to be \$1-2trill per year for the next decade. If you did basic math and added compounding, US government debt will double in the next decade. We are not even adding corporate and household debt. If you think that is small...US credit card debt is nearly \$1trill despite credit card interest rates doubling to 20+%. The US has kept the AAA for the simple reason that it's the biggest gorilla in town, but everything has limits. That brings the question, why now? The market consensus has moved away from the US recession while we always expected that risk in Q4. Despite all the patriotic rhetoric, US has ignored structural problems and piled on debt with no limit. A move by Fitch won't make any difference but it's a sign that markets are running blind into risk. RBA move to pause again has left the currency in freefall and that is a sign of substantial economic risk in asset bubbles. The answer to US and Aussie problems can't be more debt when the problem was caused by more debt. It may be different this time!

CNBC on BOJ shadow hike...The Bank of Japan has pushed back on speculation its recent policy adjustment marked the start of a tightening cycle. Deputy Governor Shinichi Ichida on Wednesday reiterated the central bank's flexible threshold for tolerance on long-term bond yields is merely a necessary modification to sustain its ultra-easy monetary policy position. On Friday, the BOJ unexpectedly loosened its yield curve control, a move some market watchers said marked the start of the end of the Japanese central bank's ultra-easy monetary policy position. "The Bank's decision to conduct yield curve control with greater flexibility aims at patiently continuing with monetary easing while nimbly responding to both upside and downside risks under extremely high uncertainties for economic activity and prices at home and abroad," Ichida said in prepared comments for a public address in Chiba prefecture. "Needless to say, we do not have an exit from monetary easing in mind," he added. Speculation about such an exit emerged after the BOJ's surprise decision to offer to "flexibly" purchase 10-year Japanese government bonds at 1% yield through fixed-rate operations. The central bank, however, stuck to its existing plan to allow yields to fluctuate in the range of around plus and minus 0.5 percentage points from its 0% target level. On Wednesday, Japan's 10-year bond yield hit yet another fresh nine-year high at about 0.63% after the BOJ left its purchase offer amounts unchanged from last month in its fixed-rate operations.

The current state of global markets is marked by a bear market cycle, with fluctuations that are causing both positive and negative outcomes for investors. The HCOB Eurozone Manufacturing PMI fell to 42.7 in July of 2023 from 43.4 in the previous month, the lowest in three years, and in line with its flash estimate to point to one full year of consecutive contractions in the currency bloc's manufacturing sector as higher borrowing costs from the ECB continued to bite. Factory production declined considerably in the period, largely due to cutbacks in the intermediate goods sector, as cleared backlogs could not entirely make up for the sharpest contraction in new orders since 2009, when excluding the first months of the pandemic. Consequently, purchasing activity was cut for another month and businesses reduced inventories. In the meantime, weak economic conditions and lower purchasing shortened delivery times and gave supply chains a breather, driving input prices sharply lower and translating to discounts in output charges.

The euro area seasonally-adjusted unemployment rate was at a record low of 6.4% in June 2023, stable compared with May 2023 and slightly below market forecasts of 6.5%. A year earlier, the jobless rate was higher at 6.7%. The unemployed decreased by 62 thousand from a month earlier to 10.814 million. Meanwhile, the youth unemployment rate, measuring job-seekers under 25 years old, dropped to an all-time low of 13.8% in June 2023, down from 14% in the previous month. Amongst the largest Euro Area economies, the lowest jobless rate was recorded in Germany (3%), while the highest rates were registered in Spain (11.7%), Italy (7.4%) and France (7.1%).

The ISM Manufacturing PMI in the United States edged higher to 46.4 in July 2023 from a nearly three-year low of 46 in June, but below market expectations of 46.8. The reading pointed to a ninth straight month of contraction in factory activity, as demand remains weak, production slowed due to lack of work, and suppliers continue to have capacity. New orders (47.3 vs 45.6), production (48.3 vs 46.7), inventories (46.1 vs 44) and backlog of orders (42.8 vs 38.7) shrank slightly less while prices went down at a smaller pace (42.6 vs 41.8). On the other hand, employment fell more (44.4 vs 48.1) and the supplier deliveries index increased to 46.1 vs 45.7, indicating faster deliveries. Meanwhile, the Customers' Inventories Index reading indicated appropriate buyer/supplier tension, which is neutral to slightly positive for future production.


The Ai Group Australian Industry Index fell by 2.8 points to -14.7 in July 2023, remaining in contraction for a 15th consecutive month. There were declines in employment (-0.5 points to -11.5), new orders (-3.6 points to -19.4) and activity/sales (-6.4 points to -19.9). By sector, the manufacturing downturn deepened by 5.8 points to -25.6, marking the lowest score since May 2020, led down by the minerals & metals. Also, the construction sector shrank sharply by 19.8 points to return to contractionary territory (-9.2) pointing to the 13 consecutive months of contraction since July 2022.


#### **Global Markets**




