




MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market was hit hard like the US market as investors prepared for the US Fed meeting tonight. The US reporting season has been patchy, and we needed big beats with multi decade high multiples. Inflation fears are rising, and US rate cut hopes are down to bare bones. The local interest rate outlook has started to ask questions about rate hikes. RBA is unlikely to hike till everything goes wrong and US Fed hikes. Given the debt bubble holding up the global asset bubbles, just about everything is possible. Japan is back to a mess despite BOJ burning balance sheet to curb the currency devaluation in recent days. It is the best example of too much stimulus for too long ending up hurting the public. We have managed to overstimulate the global economy into a mess and created the only thing that stops the world from adding more stimulus. When push comes to shove, we are going to keep adding stimulus for the rich and make the poor take the pain. We are going to blame the war, immigration and the poor. It may be different this time!

CNBC on US consumer spending...Some of America's best-known corporations are saying their consumers are being pinched by inflation as prices continue rising. Inflation has dominated corporate America's discourse over the past three years following the pandemic-induced easing of monetary policy and trillions of dollars in Covid relief. Though the pace of price growth has cooled since the Federal Reserve began raising interest rates in early 2022, consumers are still feeling the squeeze — and often tightening purse strings as costs continue climbing. "It is clear that broad-based consumer pressures persist around the world," McDonald's CEO Chris Kempczinski said on the fast-food chain's earnings call early Tuesday. "Consumers continue to be even more discriminating with every dollar that they spend as they faced elevated prices in their day-to-day spending." Sticky inflation has created a dark cloud over how everyday Americans perceive the health of the economy. Consumer confidence in April hit its lowest level since mid-2022 as high prices remained top of mind, according to data released Tuesday by the Conference Board. Worker pay has continued rising, as evidenced by first-quarter employment cost statistics released Tuesday. But so, too, have the prices paid by the typical consumer, biting into the extra income from those higher wages. To be sure, the rate of inflation has fallen significantly. The consumer price index — a broad basket of goods and services — rose at an annual rate of 3.5% in March compared with the same month a year ago. That's far below the 40-year high of 9.1% seen in mid-2022 but remains above the 2% goal set by the Fed, whose officials have pointed to stubborn inflation as the reason for keeping interest rates higher. And that tenacious 3.5% annual growth is souring economic sentiment: Even after a period of runaway inflation, prices don't actually fall.

The current state of global markets is marked by a bear market cycle, with fluctuations that are causing both positive and negative outcomes for investors. Historically, 75% of retail investors have experienced losses during positive market periods. Investors are now facing market cycles that are unprecedented in their lifetime, making risk management a crucial aspect of investing. Going forward, the trend towards active investing is reemerging as investors seek quality, relative value, profitability, and dividends. The Eurozone's economy expanded by 0.3% in the first quarter of 2024, the fastest growth rate since the third quarter of 2022, to beat market expectations of a marginal 0.1% expansion and gain traction following muted readings since the fourth quarter of 2022. The result added leeway for the European Central Bank to refrain from cutting rates to a larger extent this year should inflationary pressures prove to be more stubborn than previously expected. Among the currency bloc's largest economies, both the German and the French GDPs expanded by 0.2%, while that from Italy grew by 0.3% and that from Spain expanded by 0.7%, all above market estimates. Compared to the same quarter of the previous year, the Eurozone's GDP grew by 0.4%, beating market expectations of 0.2%, and gaining traction after two straight quarters of 0.1% growth.

The annual inflation rate in the Euro Area remained at 2.4 percent in April 2024, in line with market expectations, preliminary estimates showed. Inflation slowed for non-energy industrial goods (0.9 percent vs 1.1 percent in March) and services (3.7 percent vs 4 percent). On the other hand, prices rose faster for food, alcohol, and tobacco inflation (2.8 percent vs 2.6 percent). Meanwhile, energy prices decreased at a slower pace (-0.6 percent vs -1.8 percent). On a monthly basis, consumer prices rose by 0.4 percent in April. The core inflation rate, a crucial underlying measure that filters out volatile food and energy prices cooled to 2.7 percent, down from March's 2.9 percent.

Compensation costs for civilian workers in the United States rose by 1.2% in the first quarter of 2024, accelerating from a 0.9% increase in the previous three-month period and beating the market consensus of a 1% growth. Employment costs rose the most in one year, as wages and salaries advanced by 1.1% (vs 1.1% in Q4) and benefits increased by 1.1% (vs 0.7%). Compensation costs for private industry workers rose by 1.1% (vs 0.9%), and those for state and local government workers advanced by 1.3% (vs 1%). Year-on-year, employment costs rose by 4.2% in the January to March period, the same as in the previous three-month period.


The Ai Group Australian Industry Index fell by 3.6 points to -8.9 points in April 2024, remaining in contractionary conditions for the last twenty-four months. The industrial activity indicator reached a low point around the new year period, and has been recovering through early 2024. New orders dropped by 3.1 points to -20.0, recovering since a low around the new year period, but the indicator continues to point to significant contraction. The improvement in input volumes continued in April, and in trend terms volumes have returned to neutral. Businesses report continuing supply chain disruptions, alongside lower purchasing demand as new orders and input volumes fall. The employment indicator fell slightly by 2.2 points in April but remained positive at +2, indicating a strengthening trend since the previous winter.


Global Markets

Markets are also preparing for the US Fed interest rate update meeting where the probabilities suggest rate cuts are going to be delayed and even reduced. RUSSELL -2.09%, NASDAQ -2.04%, S&P -1.57% and DOW -1.49%. VIX pops to high 15. Yields and USD were higher, and the commodities were hit hard. US 2-year bond yield is above 5% again.




