
MARKET COMMENTARY


The Aussie market had a negative day as global markets are in holding pattern for US inflation data. We get PPI tonight and CPI tomorrow night. It makes no difference to the real economy but it's the market game. It is about rate cuts that are in free fall. We are down to 1-2 cuts from 6-7 while another strong inflation data point will further rain on rate cuts. Markets are expecting Core PPI to hold steady and Core CPI to tick down but we are talking about rounding errors here. The real economy is linked to weakening consumers and they have to be partial roadkill to deliver lower prices. No one is expecting deflation or recession but some magical soft landing where corporate earnings keep growing with inflation and consumers can pay for everything despite wage growth rolling over. US trade war with China is about to get ramped up with substantial tariffs on everything EV and semiconductor coming in the next day or two. China has been preparing and it will hurt the US economy more than China. China just had the weakest total social financing data in decades. It may be different this time!

CNBC > China and EV...Electric vehicle sales have risen sharply this year, led by growth in China and a strong demand for hybrid vehicles in particular, according to a report from Counterpoint Research. The report, released Monday, showed that sales of EV units globally, including fully battery-powered vehicles (BEVs) and hybrids, were up 18% in the first three months of 2024 compared with the same period last year. Sales of hybrid vehicles, which have both electric motors and combustion engines, vastly outpaced those of full battery-powered alternatives, rising 46% year over year. BEV sales rose 7%. "The cheaper upfront cost of [hybrids] when compared to [battery EVs] and the availability of a fuel tank that eliminates range anxiety were among the main reasons for high [hybrid] demand," Counterpoint research analyst Abhik Mukherjee said in the report.

CNBC > US Tariffs...The United States could see a significant response from China following any U.S. tariff actions, U.S. Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen said on Monday ahead of expected new tariffs targeting certain sectors this week. "President Biden believes that anything we do should be targeted to our concerns and not broad-based and hopefully we will not see a significant Chinese response. But that's always a possibility," Yellen told Bloomberg Television in an interview. Yellen's comments, given ahead of an event on broadband, come as U.S. President Joe Biden is expected to announce new tariffs on Tuesday that will include a large hike on levies for electric vehicles. The tariffs will also target semiconductors, solar equipment and medical supplies, sources told Reuters last week.

The current state of global markets is marked by a bear market cycle, with fluctuations that are causing both positive and negative outcomes for investors. US consumer inflation expectations for the year ahead increased to 3.3% in April 2024, the highest since November, from 3% in each of the previous four months. Year-ahead price expectations rose across the board, namely for gas (+0.3 percentage point to 4.8%), food (+0.2 percent point to 5.3%), medical care (+0.6 percent point to 8.7%), college education (+2.5 percentage points to 9.0%) and rent (+0.4 percentage point to 9.1%). Also, median home price growth expectations increased to 3.3%, the highest since July 2022, after remaining unchanged at 3% for seven consecutive months. Meanwhile, inflation expectations at the three-year horizon decreased to 2.8% from 2.9% but increased to 2.8% from 2.6% at the five-year horizon. In addition, median one-year-ahead expected earnings growth decreased by 0.1 percentage point to 2.7% and unemployment expectations increased by 1 percentage point to 37.2%.

Producer prices in Japan increased by 0.9% yoy in April 2024, holding steady for the second straight month and matching market consensus. It was the 39th straight month of growth in producer prices, remaining the highest wholesale inflation since last October as cost continued to rise for most components: transport equipment (1.7% vs 2.1% in March), beverages & food (2.9% vs 4.0%), petroleum & coal (5.3% vs 5.3%), electrical machinery (3.3% vs 4.5%), production machinery (5.0% vs 4.6%), metal products (2.9% vs 3.4%), other manufacturing (5.3% vs 5.5%), general-purpose machinery (3.2% vs 3.8%), non-ferrous metals (11.7% vs 5.8%), business-oriented machinery (2.9% vs 4.0%), and information (3.3% vs 2.2%). At the same time, prices of plastic products bounced back (0.5% vs -0.3%). By contrast, cost fell for chemicals (-0.6% vs 0.2%) and iron & steel (-0.6% vs -3.1%). Monthly, producer prices rose 0.3%, the most in four months, after a 0.2% rise in the prior two months.

Germany's consumer prices inflation was confirmed at 2.2% in April 2024, unchanged from a nearly three-year-low in the previous month, nearing the European Central Bank's target of 2.0%. A slowdown in services inflation (3.4% vs 3.7% in March) was offset by a rebound in food prices (0.5% vs -0.7%) and a smaller decrease in energy costs (-1.2% vs -2.7%) due to the end of a temporary tax cut on natural gas this month. Core inflation, excluding volatile items like food and energy, declined to 3.0% in April, its lowest level since March 2022. Monthly, the CPI rose 0.5%, the most in 13 months, after a 0.4% gain in March. Meanwhile, the EU-harmonized rate edged higher to 2.4%, up from March's near three-year low of 2.3%.

Spain's annual consumer price inflation was confirmed at 3.3% in April 2024, the highest in three months, up from 3.2% in March. The main upward pressure came from prices of housing & utilities (4% vs 1.5% in March), namely electricity, gas and other fuels (5.7% vs -0.6%), and food & non-alcoholic beverages (4.7% vs 4.3%), of which fruits & vegetables. The core rate, excluding volatile items like food and energy, was 2.9% in April, the lowest since January 2022, down from 3.3% in March. Spain's European Union-harmonised 12-month inflation hit a three-month high of 3.4% in April, slightly up from 3.3% in March and matching the preliminary estimate. Compared to the previous month, the national CPI increased by 0.7% in April, matching the preliminary estimate; and the EU harmonized rose by 0.6%, also in line with an earlier reading.

Global Markets

The US market started positive and faded to flat again as investors wait for inflation data. US consumer inflation expectations jumped for the first time since Aug. Indian inflation came in higher than expected despite food export bans during the current election. South Korean import and export prices jump as inflation bites another manufacturing country. DOW -0.21%, S&P -0.02%, RUSSELL +0.11% and NASDAQ +0.29%. VIX pops to mid-13. Yields and USD were tick lower. Oil pops on OPEC looking to extend cuts. Gas is popping higher and hitting the Jan level. Gold lower and Copper higher. Tech and Property were the only positive sectors while Industrials and Financials were the worst. European markets were mainly weaker.

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
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
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1. Movers and Shakers in S&P 300 >
