


MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market had a negative day with big global trade and very little local trade. Shadow reporting season has started, and it wasn't pretty today. JHX led the bashing while SHL recovered from the initial hit. Some of the beaten-up small caps bounced but macro remains weak. The employment market and consumer outlook remain weak and keeps falling around the world. Australia is no different in that aspect. We get PPI tonight and CPI tomorrow night. It makes no difference to the real economy but it's the market game. The commodity squeeze is playing out in several metals while there is no demand driven data to back it up. Global growth is falling while Copper pops to an all-time high. Gold is hitting a new all-time high every day and the market seems to think that is normal. Japan is showing who things can get bad with weak policy setting. Geopolitics is ramping up and the market continues to ignore. Eventually the consumers are going to fall and then everyone will panic but then it's too late. It may be different this time!

CNBC on Consumer Spending > Wendy's will offer a \$3 breakfast combination meal starting Monday, as restaurant chains look for new ways to drive sales while consumers pull back on dining out. The deal will include a small portion of seasoned potatoes and a choice of either a bacon, egg and cheese English muffin or a sausage, egg and cheese English muffin, the fast-food chain said. The promotion comes as Wendy's rival McDonald's plans a similar yet limited value meal option as it tries to boost traffic. Last week, CNBC reported the fast-food giant's \$5 meal deal would be available in stores for only a month, starting June 25. Consumers have become more selective about where they spend their dollars, and some restaurants have started to see a long-expected consumer pullback. Other fast-casual chains have enjoyed strong sales despite higher prices. As inflation lingers, companies that cater to lower-income consumers have faced a particular challenge bringing in customers. Wendy's earlier this month reported first-quarter revenue grew a modest 1.1% to \$534.8 million. Its same restaurant sales worldwide grew only 0.9% in the quarter. McDonald's missed first-quarter earnings expectations last month. Although higher prices have helped the chain's revenue, they have scared away some low-income customers. Chief Financial Officer Ian Borden said the company has adopted a "street-fighting mentality" to compete for value-minded diners. KFC, Pizza Hut and Taco Bell owner Yum Brands also posted a disappointing earnings report earlier this month, as revenue missed Wall Street estimates. The company cited same-store sales declines for KFC and Pizza Hut.

The current state of global markets is marked by a bear market cycle, with fluctuations that are causing both positive and negative outcomes for investors. Historically, 75% of retail investors have experienced losses during positive market periods. Investors are now facing market cycles that are unprecedented in their lifetime, making risk management a crucial aspect of investing. Going forward, the trend towards active investing is reemerging as investors seek quality, relative value, profitability, and dividends. The Composite Consumer Sentiment Index (CCSI) fell to 98.4 points in May 2024, after remaining at its highest level since August 2023 for two consecutive months. Consumer sentiment regarding current living standards fell by one point lower from the previous month to 88, and that concerning the future outlook lost two points to stay 92 level. Consumer sentiment related to future household income dropped two points to 97, and that concerning future household spending was one point lower than in the previous month, at 109. Consumer sentiment concerning current domestic economic conditions dipped one point to 67, and that concerning future domestic economic conditions was two points lower than in the previous month, at 79. The expected inflation rate for the upcoming year was 3.2%.

Australia's Westpac-Melbourne Institute Consumer Sentiment index fell 0.3% month-over-month to 82.4 in May 2024, slowing from April's 2.4% decline. It was the third straight month of decrease, marking the softest pace in the sequence and coming after Treasurer Chalmers announced the country's budget focusing on boosting employment and easing cost-of-living pressures. The 12-month outlook for the economy rose 0.7% while the 5-year outlook jumped 2.6%. Consumers were also slightly more positive about the outlook for family finances. However, their assessments of the current family finances weakened. Also, the index measuring whether it was a good time to buy major household items fell further despite its rate of decline softening sharply. "While expectations improved a touch, this was overshadowed by a further deterioration in current conditions and fears that persistently high inflation may require further interest rate rises," said Westpac senior economist Matthew Hassan.


Producer prices in Germany declined by 3.3% year-on-year in April 2024, following a 2.9% drop in the previous month, compared to market forecasts of a 3.2% fall. It marked the tenth consecutive month of producer deflation, dragged by a decline in energy costs (-8.2%), influenced by natural gas (-18.0%) and electricity (-14.0%). Meanwhile, prices of intermediate goods dropped by 3.1%, weighed by paperboard and paper products (-7.7%), metals (-5.8%), and basic chemicals (-6.6%). By contrast, prices of non-durable consumer goods increased by 0.3%, while those of durable consumer goods climbed by 1.0%. Also, prices of capital goods advanced 2.4%, mainly driven by rises in machinery prices (2.8%) and the prices of motor vehicles, trailers, and semi-trailers (1.7%). On a monthly basis, producer prices were up by 0.2%, the same pace as in March, and matching forecasts.

Global Markets

The US market had another flat day with NASDAQ stocks up and DOW stocks down. Usual pump candidates tend to be in one of these easily manipulated indices and usually only one moves but today they moved against each other. Apart from countless US Fed talkers adding to volatility, Mexican retail sales fell more than expected and the most since the pandemic. JPM's Dimon flagged getting closer to retirement. Microsoft uses Qualcomm chips in their PCs. Iranian President dies in a helicopter crash and finger pointing has started. International Criminal Court prosecutor is seeking arrest warrants for Netanyahu, his defense minister and some Hamas leaders for war crimes. Metal and Food prices are running hot on speculation and inflation will follow. DOW -0.49%, S&P +0.09%, RUSSELL +0.32% and NASDAQ +0.65%. VIX ticks up at low 12. Yields and USD were higher. Gold and Copper hit new highs as Oil was a bit weaker despite Middle East unrest. Oil seems to be way too manipulated given the rise in supply risk in recent months. Tech and Communication were the clear pump sectors while Financials and Retail were taking hits. European markets were slightly higher.


