


MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market started the week with a negative day. The global macro has kept on sliding into low growth uncertainty while rate cut hopes are getting pushed back. EU political uncertainty has popped with French elections while US Fed rained on everyone's rate cut hopes. ECB rate cut looks to be more political and less data driven but who is data driven anyway. The employment market is starting to crack around the word while fake policies have meme stocks moving like a yo-yo. The real economy is a mess where the majority of the people in western economies are already in recession and yet the US Fed is confused why the US people are downbeat on the economy. May be because US Fed boosted liquidity for two years while claiming to tighten financial conditions and kept the inflation beast going. Now they are dealing with 20+% inflation and PPI since pre pandemic. China data shows the world is slowing but they are holding up. Get ready for mergers and cap raises as fading businesses try to survive. The China stimulus stories are not working anymore. We are stuck in elevated inflation and rates with no plan B. It may be different this time!

CNBC on Aus & China > Australia's Prime Minister Anthony Albanese and Chinese Premier Li Qiang met on Monday in the first visit to the country by a Chinese premier in seven years, with trade ties, regional security and a jailed Australian writer on the host's agenda. The visit by Li, China's top-ranked official after President Xi Jinping, marks a stabilization in relations between the U.S. security ally and the world's second-biggest economy, after a frosty period of Beijing blocking \$20 billion in Australian exports and friction over defense encounters. "We welcome the continued stabilization and development of our bilateral relations. This dialogue has allowed us to build a deeper awareness of our respective interests," Albanese said in opening remarks. Australia and China had complementary economies and shared interests in addressing climate change, he said. "We also have our differences... that's why candid dialogue is so important. For Australia, we consistently advocate the importance of a region and world that is peaceful, stable and prosperous, where countries respect sovereignty and abide by international laws," he said. After the meeting, Li told reporters the leaders held a "candid, in-depth and fruitful meeting and reached a lot of consensus". "We both agreed to uphold the right characterization of our bilateral relationship and consolidate its momentum...and handling this relationship in a positive attitude," he said. The two countries would expand cooperation in energy and mining, and China would include Australia in its visa waiver program, he added. "We both stressed the importance of maintaining communication and coordination to jointly safeguard peace and prosperity in the region and beyond," he said.

The current state of global markets is marked by a bear market cycle, with fluctuations that are causing both positive and negative outcomes for investors. Japan's core machinery orders, which exclude those for ships and electric power companies, fell 2.9% month-on-month to 885.3 billion yen in April 2024, reversing from a 2.9% gain in March but coming in better than market expectations for a 3.1% decline. The decrease in capital spending was driven by a sharp decline in the manufacturing sector which dropped 11.3% to 419.4 billion yen in April, while the non-manufacturing sector saw an increase of 5.9% to 475.3 billion yen. The highly volatile data series is considered as a leading indicator of capital spending in the coming six to nine months. On an annual basis, private-sector machinery orders increased 0.7% in April.

The ANZ-Indeed Australian Job Ads declined 2.1% month-on-month in May 2024, improving slightly from a 2.3% drop in April but remaining negative for the fourth consecutive month. "The (revised) ANZ-Indeed Australian Job Ads series shows a softening over 2024, with an 8.2% fall since the end of last year. Other data also show the labour market is cooling, but only gradually," said ANZ Economic Madeline Dunk. Indeed Senior Economist, Callam Pickering also said: "In May, the decline in ANZ-Indeed Job Ads was relatively broad-based, with the largest subtractions coming from Victoria and Western Australia. The annual fall has been concentrated in New South Wales and Victoria, with more minor declines across the rest of Australia.".

China's new home prices decreased by 3.9% year-on-year in May 2024, falling further from a 3.1% drop in the previous month. It marked the 11th consecutive period of declining home prices and the steepest since June 2015, despite more property market stimulus from the government. Prices dropped at stronger rates in Guangzhou (-8.3% vs -6.9% in April), Beijing (-1.8% vs -0.5%), and Shenzhen (-7.4% vs -6.7%). At the same time, costs in Tianjin fell 0.7% after previously stabilizing, while prices in Shanghai continued to rise further (4.5% vs 4.2%). On a monthly basis, new home prices declined by 0.7% in May, following a 0.6% decrease in the prior period.

China's industrial production expanded by 5.6% year-on-year in May 2024, coming less than market expectations of a 6% rise and easing from a 6.7% growth in the previous month. Output slowed for manufacturing (6% vs 7.5% in April) and utilities (4.3% vs 5.8%), while activity accelerated for mining (3.6% vs 2%). In terms of industries, 33 out of 41 major sectors posted growth, notably from chemical products (12.7%), other transportation equipment (11.8%), automobile (7.6%), textiles (5.3%), and wine, beverage and refined tea (5.1%). Compared to the prior month, industrial activity grew 0.3%, slowing from a 1% increase in April. On a year-to-date basis, industrial output was 6.2% higher than the same period last year.

China's retail sales grew by 3.7% year-on-year in May 2024, accelerating from a fifteen-month low of 2.3% rise in the previous month and compared to market forecasts of 3% gain. This marked the 16th consecutive month of growth in retail trade, and the sharpest since February 2024, as sales grew for grain, oils & food (9.3% vs 8.5% in April), home appliances (12.9% vs 4.5%), oil products (5.1% vs 1.6%), personal care (7.7% vs 4.4%), furniture (4.8% vs 1.2%) and communications equipment (16.6% vs 13.3%). Additionally, sales rebounded for clothing (4.4% vs -2%) and office supplies (4.3% vs -4.4%), while decreased at a softer pace for car (-4.4% vs -5.6%). In contrast, sales slowed for tobacco & alcohol (7.7% vs 8.4%) and Chinese & Western medicine (4.3% vs 7.8%).


Global Markets

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
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
