
MARKET COMMENTARY

The EV trade war has started with EU raising tariffs as high as 45% against Chinese EV. The US election is a choice between gradual debt growth and dramatic debt growth. There is no policy for growth or debt repayment, it is all about holding the economy from falling on one side and gutting it for vested interest group on the other side. Locally the media hit job on the government is about the PM not declaring Qantas' upgrades. In the era of helicopter rides and sports rorts, we are worried about a problem that almost everyone in Canberra has had. Spot gold is hitting new all-time highs daily in US\$ and A\$. The policy mistakes by governments and central banks are reaching high school standards. We have given up on most of the population and reverted to fudging data to make things look better for the election cycle. If you are wondering why people are voting for a party or a group that is going to be negative for them, it is not that they are dumb voters, but they have given up. CNBC on EU/China EV trade war > China's commerce ministry said it "does not accept" tariffs imposed by the European Union on Chinese electric vehicles, after the bloc increased tariffs on Chinese EVs to as high as 45.3% on Wednesday. The extra tariffs will range from 7.8% for Tesla to 35.3% for SAIC Motor, and stack on top of the 10% standard import duty for cars to the EU. In a statement, the ministry said that "China has repeatedly pointed out that the EU's anti-subsidy investigation on Chinese electric vehicles has many unreasonable and non-compliant aspects and is a protectionist practice of 'unfair competition'," according to a Google translation. The EU launched an "anti-subsidy" investigation into Chinese EVs last year, alleging they were illegally subsidized and thereby "causes or threatens to cause economic injury" to the bloc's EV industry.

CNBC on US Election and Economy > Top allies and surrogates of former President Donald Trump, including Tesla CEO Elon Musk, are agreeing with economists who say Trump's economic policy plans would raise prices for consumers, but Trump's allies contend the effect would be short-term and would be worth it in the long run. On Tuesday, Musk agreed with a social media post on X, whose author said that the Republican presidential nominee's policy proposals could spark a "severe overreaction in the economy" that would mean "markets will tumble" before getting back to a "sounder footing." "Sounds about right," responded Musk, one of Trump's most high-profile billionaire backers. Dozens of independent economists, Wall Street analysts and researchers have warned that Trump's second-term proposals threaten to swell the federal deficit and reheat inflation.

Historically, 75% of retail investors have experienced losses during positive market periods. Australian Trading Day Market Report

The US trade deficit widened sharply to \$108.2 billion in September of 2024 from the \$94.2 billion gap in the earlier month, the widest deficit since commodity supply threats triggered by the Russian invasion of Ukraine drove the trade gap to widen to a record in March 2022. Imports surged by 3.8% from the previous month to \$282.1 billion, with notable increases for consumer goods (5.8% to \$70.9 billion), capital goods (3.1% to \$86 billion), industrial supplies (3.8% to \$55.8 billion), and foods, feeds, and beverages (4.6% to \$18.8 billion). In turn, exports fell by 2% to \$174.2 billion, amid declines for capital goods (-3.3% to \$55.9 billion), industrial supplies (-2.5% to \$59.7 billion), and consumer goods (-6.3% to \$21.3 billion).

The number of job openings fell by 418,000 to 7.443 million in September 2024 from a downwardly revised 7.861 million in August and below market expectations of 7.99 million. It is the lowest level since January 2021, indicating the labor market is cooling. Job openings decreased in health care and social assistance, and government. The number of job openings decreased in health care and social assistance (-178,000); state and local government, excluding education (-79,000); and federal government (-28,000) but increased in finance and insurance (+85,000). Regarding regional distribution, job openings dropped in the South (-325,000), in the West (-63,000), in the Midwest (-24,000) and in the Northeast (-8,000). Meanwhile, the number of hires and total separations changed little at 5.6 million and 5.2 million, respectively. Within separations, quits (3.1 million) and layoffs and discharges (1.8 million) changed little.

Australia's annual inflation rate dropped to 2.8% in Q3 2024 from 3.8% in Q2, steeper than market expectations of 2.9%. It was the lowest reading since Q1 2021, with goods inflation sharply slowing (1.4% vs 3.2% in Q2), mainly due to declines in electricity and fuel prices amid the continued impact of Energy Bill Relief Fund rebates. Meanwhile, services inflation stayed elevated (4.6% vs 4.5%). Notably, prices eased for alcohol and tobacco (6.7% vs 6.8% in Q2), clothing (1.7% vs 2.9%), housing (2.8% vs 5.2%), health (4.8% vs 5.7%), and financial services (6.2% vs 6.4%). In addition, transport costs fell for the first time since Q4 2020 (-0.9% vs 4.6%). In contrast, inflation was steady for food (at 3.3%), while costs accelerated for recreation (2.1% vs 0.9%), education (6.4% vs 5.6%), and household services (0.7% vs -1.1%). The RBA's Trimmed Mean CPI rose 3.5% yot, the softest gain in nearly three years, aligning with consensus but still exceeding the central bank's 2-3% target.


The monthly Consumer Price Index (CPI) in Australia increased by 2.1% year-on-year in September 2024, coming in below market forecasts of 2.4% and August's reading of 2.7%. This was the lowest figure since July 2021, bringing inflation within the central bank's target range of 2 to 3% for the second consecutive month, largely due to the ongoing impact of the Energy Bill Relief Fund rebate. Electricity prices saw a record decrease (-24.1% vs -17.9% in August), while automotive fuel experienced its steepest decline since December 2020 (-14.0% vs -7.6%). Simultaneously, prices moderated for food (3.3% vs 3.4%), alcohol and tobacco (6.3% vs 6.6%), health (4.8% vs 5.3%), and recreation & culture (2.4% vs 2.5%). Meanwhile, inflation accelerated for education (6.4% vs 5.4%). Excluding volatile items and travel, the CPI rose by 2.7% in September, marking the lowest increase since November 2021, down from 3.0% in August.

Global Markets

The US market started positively and faded to close mainly flat. UK money supply grew faster than expected. US goods trade balance and retail/wholesale inventory growth were weaker than expected. JOLT job data was weaker than expected. API crude stock showed that the US keeps dumping oil on the market. DOW - 0.36%, RUSSELL -0.27%, S&P +0.16% and NASDAQ +0.78%. VIX slides to mid-19. Yields and USD ticked lower. Oil and Copper were mainly flat while Gold jumps to new all-time high in USD and AUD. Aussie gold miners are selling above A\$4200 today. European markets were negative.


