
#### MARKET COMMENTARY


The Aussie market started mainly positively and finished mainly flat to end a negative week to start the new month. The US is trying to defund anything that is not linked to their vested interest groups to save over \$1trill to pay for the unaffordable tax cuts. That means they are in the process of finding new excuses to cut funding to emerging market economies and war-torn countries. Some of those countries are where they are due to US policies of the past. As history shows with Australia doing this in pacific, China will move in and then it costs Australia even more to recover from the lack of soft power. Just in case the world wasn't sure that US is playing to the tune of vested interest groups, (1) US cut future funding for South Africa (2) shutting down USAID (3) planning to take over Gaza and kick Palestinians out and (4) sanctioned ICC for charging Israel and Hamas leaders. It is clear the policy settings are chasing two targets...unaffordable tax cuts and satisfying vested interest groups. It is likely to come at risk to their economy via weaker growth and higher inflation. China is ramping up geopolitics with retaliatory tariffs and blacklisting. EU, UK and India are classic examples of central banks cutting rates despite inflation fears and devaluing currency. Australia is planning to join the rate cut mess despite very strong economic data and currency/inflation risk. It may be different this time!

CNBC on Global Rate Cycle > The Bank of England lowered interest rates by 25 basis points on Thursday, following the European Central Bank's cut of the same amount on Jan. 30. The Reserve Bank of India is also widely expectedly to trim its repo rate by 25 basis points when its policy meeting ends on Friday. Many economies seem to be settling into a lower-rate environment as policymakers look to boost economic growth. That's in stark contrast with the U.S. — it's unclear if the U.S. Federal Reserve would even deliver on its two rate cuts in 2025, forecast in December, given the uncertainties over the economic impact of U.S. President Donald Trump's policies. Ahead of Trump's inauguration, the U.S. dollar began strengthening and hit its highest level in more than two years, as measured by the U.S. dollar index.

CNBC on India Rate Cycle > The Reserve Bank of India on Friday cut key interest rates for the first time in nearly five years, as cooling inflation offers the central bank room to stimulate the economy. The Monetary Policy Committee decided to trim the repo rate by 25 basis points to 6.25%, RBI Governor Sanjay Malhotra said in a livestreamed address. The rate reduction was widely expected and marked RBI's first cut since May 2020 when the country battled the pandemic-inflicted downturn. The decision confirmed that the central bank's priorities have "tilted from containing inflation to providing more support for the economy," Shilan Shah, deputy chief emerging markets economist at Capital Economics said in a note.

Historically, 75% of retail investors have experienced losses during positive market periods. Investors are now facing market cycles that are unprecedented in their lifetime, making risk management a crucial aspect of investing. Going forward, the trend towards active investing is reemerging as investors seek quality, relative value, profitability, and dividends. The Bank of England cut its benchmark Bank Rate by 25bps to 4.5% in its February 2025 decision, as expected, to mark the third rate cut since the start of its cutting cycle in August of last year. All nine members of the Monetary Policy Committee voted for a rate cut, compared with bets of an 8-to-1 vote, while two members voted for a steeper 50bps cut, including known-hawk Catherine Mann. The Bank maintained its stance that monetary easing is expected to be gradual this year, as mounting growth concerns weigh against stubborn levels of underlying services inflation. Still, the Bank revised its growth forecasts for the current year downward as economic activity has already underperformed expectations from November, indicating a dovish shift in the risk balance between growth and higher prices in the near term.

US employers announced 49,795 job cuts in January 2025, above 38,792 in December 2024 but down 40% from 82,307 a year earlier. It is also the lowest January job cut total since 2022. "January was relatively quiet in terms of job cut announcements. However, we've already seen major announcements in the early days of February, so it seems this quiet is unlikely to last," said Andrew Challenger, Senior VP of Challenger, Gray & Christmas, Inc. Technology led all sectors in job-cutting activity in January with 7,488. "Technology firms are being disrupted by AI integration, and many bellwether Tech companies are discussing efficiency and productivity initiatives, which means additional cuts may be coming," said Challenger. Retail followed with 6,419 job cuts. The West experienced the highest number of layoffs at 19,899 and closures drove the highest number of layoffs with 16,123, followed by restructuring efforts (12,618 job losses) and market and economic conditions (8,159).


Household spending in Japan increased by 2.7% year-on-year in December 2024, easily beating market estimates of 0.2% and marking the first growth in five months. This was the strongest rise since August 2022, boosted by a winter bonus. Expenditure bounced back for clothing and footwear (4.1% vs -13.7% in November), transport and communication (6.5% vs -0.5%), culture & recreation (0.7% vs -2.9%), other consumption (5.2% vs -2.7%), and miscellaneous items (13.1% vs -5.9%). At the same time, spending grew further for both housing (15.8% vs 18.7%) and medical care (4.6% vs 0.8%). Simultaneously, education expenditure sharply eased (3.8% vs 31.9%) amid continued falls in spending on food (-1.2% vs -0.6%), fuel, light & water charges (-2.4% vs -2.9%), and furniture and household goods (-1.4% vs -13.8%). Monthly, personal spending rose by 2.3%, accelerating from a 0.4% gain in November and defying expectations of a 0.5% decrease. This also marked the third consecutive month of expansion

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) lowered its key repo rate by 25 bps to 6.25%, marking the first rate cut since May 2020 during the February meeting. This move comes amid a recent slowdown in economic growth and global trade uncertainty, as widely expected. It was Governor Sanjay Malhotra's first monetary policy review since taking charge as the 26th RBI governor last December. The decision brings borrowing costs to their lowest level since January 2023. The central bank expects the GDP growth for FY2025-26 at 6.7% while maintaining its inflation forecast at 4.2%, with projections of 4.5% for Q1, 4.0% for Q2, and 3.8% for Q3. The food inflation is expected to soften on the back of new crop arrival. Moreover, the RBI also cuts the standing deposit facility (SDF) rate by 25 bps to 6% and the marginal standing facility (MSF) and bank rates to 6.50%. The RBI maintained the Cash Reserve Ratio at 4%, after slashing 50bps in the December meeting.

Japan's leading economic indicators index, which gauges the economic outlook for the coming months based on data such as job offers and consumer sentiment, increased to 108.9 in December 2024, up from November's three-month low of 107.8, and surpassing market estimates of 108.1. The latest figure came as the unemployment rate edged lower to 2.4% in December, with employment showing a moderate upward trend during the month. Additionally, household spending rose for the first time in five months, marking the fastest growth since August 2022. Meanwhile, consumer sentiment weakened slightly in December.

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
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
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#### 1. Movers and Shakers in S&P 300 >
