
# **MARKET COMMENTARY**

The Aussie market started positively and faded to flat as global funds defended the market after US inflation came in hotter than expected and climbed higher at headline and core level. US inflation is rising faster than expected and we haven't even started to see tariffs flow into it yet. The Trump administration is claiming that they will add more tariffs to counter the tariffs that were retaliatory to the initial US tariffs. If that sounds stupid, well...that pretty much explains the US policy setting. Musk is running around cutting every agency that attacked him in the past and proving the logic that self-managing conflict of interest has never worked. We have barely started the trade war and already Musk has flipped from more than \$2trill saving to barely \$1trill to more than \$1trill as debt blow out becomes obvious. Previous government was running a heavy debt burn and Trump administration is running even bigger burn rate. Republicans are calling for debt ceiling to be raised by \$4trill to cover the debt blow out from unaffordable tax cuts that is expected costs around \$4.5trill. Despite the spin about so many cuts and savings from DOGE, no one has been changed with anything despite Musk's claims of fraud. The US Fed is not cutting while debt is blowing up. US has no choice but to ramp up tax and tariff fantasy is the only option. Baring another Middle East war, ramped up geopolitics with Trumpflation is the least bad political solution. It may be different this time!

CNBC on Rate Cut Cycle > A Federal Reserve interest rate cut won't be coming until at least September, if at all this year, following a troubling inflation report Wednesday, according to updated market pricing. Futures markets shifted from the expectation of a June cut and possibly another before the end of the year to no moves until the fall, with a minimal chance of a follow-up before the end of 2025. Reduced optimism for Fed easing came after the January consumer price index report showed a 0.5% monthly gain, pushing the annual inflation rate to 3%, a touch higher than December and only slightly lower than the 3.1% reading in January 2024. Excluding food and energy, the news was even worse, with a 3.3% rate that showed core inflation, which the Fed tends to rely on more, also rising and holding well above the central bank's goal.

CNBC on Chinese adoption of DeepSeek > Chinese businesses are tapping DeepSeek's newest artificial intelligence model to see how it can improve productivity. The Chinese AI model took the world by storm in recent weeks after showcasing its reasoning process and claims to undercut rival OpenAI's ChatGPT on cost — despite U.S. restrictions on Chinese access to the advanced semiconductors needed to develop the tech. Eight automakers including BYD, at least nine financial securities companies, three state-owned telecommunications operators and smartphone brand Honor are among the many that have rushed in the last week to integrate with DeepSeek. Cloud computing operators Alibaba, Huawei, Tencent and Baidu have all offered ways for clients to access DeepSeek's latest model.

Historically, 75% of retail investors have experienced losses during positive market periods. Industrial production in India grew by 3.2% year-on-year in December 2024, slowing from a downwardly revised 5% rise in November and falling short of market expectations of a 3.9% gain. This was mainly due to a slowdown in manufacturing activity (3% vs 5.5% in November). Meanwhile, production rose further for mining (2.6% vs 1.9%) and electricity (6.2% vs 4.4%). On a monthly basis, industrial output increased by 6.1% in December, rebounding from an upwardly revised 1.4% drop in the previous month. In the April-December period, industrial production rose by 4%.

The annual inflation rate in the US edged up to 3% in January 2025, compared to 2.9% in December 2024, and above market forecasts of 2.9%, indicating stalled progress in curbing inflation. Energy costs rose 1% year-on-year, the first increase in six months, after a 0.5% fall in December, mainly due to gasoline (-0.2% vs -3.4%), fuel oil (-5.3% vs -13.1%) and natural gas (4.9% vs 4.9%). Also, prices for used cars and trucks rebounded (1% vs -3.3%), cost accelerated for transportation (8% vs 7.3%) and fell less for new vehicles (-0.3% vs -0.4%). On the other hand, inflation steadied for food (2.5% vs 2.5%) and slowed for shelter (4.4% vs 4.6%). On a monthly basis, the CPI rose by 0.5%, above 0.4% in the previous month and expectations it would slow to 0.3%. The index for shelter rose 0.4%, accounting for nearly 30% of the increase. Meanwhile, annual core inflation unexpectedly rose to 3.3%, compared to forecasts it would slow to 3.1%. The monthly rate edged up more than expected to 0.4%.


The US government reported a budget deficit of \$129 billion in January, a sharp increase from the previous year's unusually low \$22 billion shortfall. This figure also exceeded the forecasted deficit of \$88.1 billion, largely driven by calendar shifts in benefit payments, alongside rising expenditures on Social Security, Medicare, and interest costs. The Treasury noted that January receipts rose 8% year-over-year to \$513 billion, but outlays climbed at a much faster pace, increasing 29% to \$642 billion. Adjusting for calendar shifts, the deficit for January would have been a more modest \$21 billion. Meanwhile, the fiscal year-to-date deficit reached a record \$840 billion for the first four months of 2025, marking a 58% increase from the prior year. This jump was partially attributed to inflated tax receipts in the previous fiscal year due to deferred payments. Both receipts and outlays for the first four months hit record highs, highlighting the growing fiscal strain on the government.

Producer prices in Japan increased by 4.2% yoy in January 2025, accelerating from an upwardly revised 3.9% gain in the prior month and exceeding market consensus of 4.0%. It was the 47th straight month of producer inflation, marking the highest print since May 2023. Upward price pressures came from most components: transport equipment (1.5% vs 1.8% in Dec.), beverages & foods (2.9% vs 2.2%), petroleum & coal (2.6% vs - 0.6%), electrical machinery (3.7% vs 4.8%), production machinery (2.5% vs 1.9%), general-purpose machinery (3.7% vs 4.4%), metal products (4.5% vs 4.1%), other manufacturing (3.7% vs 3.7%), plastics (3.4% vs 3.7%), non-ferrous metals (14.3% vs 12.7%), information (2.7% vs 2.5%), and business-oriented machinery (1.4% vs 2.1%). In contrast, prices fell for chemical products (-0.3% vs -0.3%), iron & steel (-0.8% vs -0.1%), and lumber and wood (-3.4% vs -2.6%). Monthly, producer prices rose by 0.3%, matching estimates while slightly easing from a 0.4% growth in December.

Consumer inflation expectations in Australia increased to 4.6% in February 2025 from 4.0% in the previous month, marking the highest reading since April 2024. This result preceded the Reserve Bank's first monetary policy meeting of the year, scheduled for mid-February, and a pre-election budget in March. In December, the central bank kept the cash rate unchanged at 4.35% for the ninth consecutive meeting, amid elevated underlying inflation. The board indicated that the level was sufficiently restrictive to guide inflation toward its target range while maintaining employment gains. Meantime, the monthly CPI index rose by 2.5% year-on-year in December, the most in four months, as the impact of government energy rebates subsided. However, the country's annual inflation stood at 2.4% in Q4 of 2024, pointing to the lowest figure since Q1 2021. Meanwhile, the trimmed mean CPI rose 3.2%, falling short of consensus of 3.3% but still surpassing the central bank's 2-3% target.




