
# **MARKET COMMENTARY**

The Aussie market started positively and faded through the day as global funds were taking profit in the two biggest stocks that they use to manipulate the outcome. It has been obvious in recent weeks that CBA and BHP are pushed up on bad days to hold up the market while sold down on good days to free up capital to defend the market on weak days. The classic example we had previously was when the market had a negative day while CBA was up over 4%. Today was the opposite where market was up and global funds were liquidating the overweight position in CBA and BHP to the point that they were negative. US markets are leading the global sentiment, and they are experiencing insider selling and massive outflows while rammed up buybacks in tech are hiding the reality. The US economy is going to start to see shortages in a few weeks. Trumponomics is playing chicken with economic reality. It may be different this time!

CNBC on Trade War > U.S. President Donald Trump's "America First" ideology, which, generally speaking, prioritizes the domestic over the international, rests on the assumption that the world needs America more than it needs the world. This may be true for the status quo. The U.S. is the world's largest importer and among the biggest exporters, according to the World Integrated Trade Solution, a database provided by the World Trade Organization. And its policies are already being felt: Factories in China are struggling to fill their order books because of increased export costs to the U.S. But change is afoot. Countries are finding ways to respond to Trump's nationalistic gestures. Southeast Asian nations, which suffered the brunt of Trump tariffs, are banding together to increase intra-regional trade and diversify their export destinations. China, after assessing the severity of Trump's threats, seems to be ready to strengthen its fiscal stimulus, and is likewise expanding to other overseas markets.

CNBC on Chinese prepares for long trade war > Senior Chinese officials on Monday outlined plans to support jobs and help exporters, while hinting at the possibility of more stimulus in light of rising trade tensions with the U.S. In just a few weeks, tit-for-tat tariffs between the U.S. and China have more than doubled to over 100%, forcing Chinese factories to pause production and tell some workers to stay home. Exports have been a rare bright spot in China's economy, which has faced pressure from lackluster consumption and a real estate slump. "Labor market stability remains a critical concern for Chinese policymakers, given its direct linkage to social stability and consumption recovery," Goldman Sachs analysts said in a report Sunday. They estimate around 16 million jobs in China are involved in the production of goods exported to the U.S. Authorities on Monday acknowledged the impact of trade tensions on jobs at exporting companies. China has repeatedly emphasized that consumption is its priority for the year. But Monday's press conference focused more on efforts to stabilize employment.

Retail sales in the UK rose by 0.4% month-over-month in March 2025, defying forecasts of a 0.4% decline, following a downwardly revised 0.7% increase in the previous month. Sales in non-food stores increased by 1.7%, reaching its highest level since March 2022. Clothing stores saw the strongest growth (+3.7%), with retailers attributing the boost to favorable weather. Other non-food stores also saw a gain (+2.4%), particularly in second-hand goods stores and retailers selling garden supplies. Meanwhile, food store sales declined by 1.3%. Excluding fuel, retail sales grew by 0.5% from a month earlier. On a yearly basis, retail sales climbed 2.6%, exceeding forecasts and February's 1.8% increase. For the first quarter, retail trade rose by 1.6%, marking the largest three-month increase since July 2021.

Economic activity in Mexico decreased by 0.7% year-on-year in February 2025, the steepest fall since March 2024, following a flat reading in January, but slightly better than forecasts of a 0.8% contraction. Multiple sectors saw declines, including mining (-9.2%), agriculture (-4.1%), animal husbandry and livestock farming (-2.3%), and manufacturing (-0.3%). On the other hand, construction rose by 0.4%. The services sector fell by 0.3%, driven mainly by a sharp decline in wholesale trade (-8.5%) and transport, mail, and warehousing (-3.7%). Meanwhile, the largest increases were recorded in professional, scientific, and technical services (20.6%) and business support, waste management, and remediation services (16.5%). On a monthly basis, economic activity rose by 1%.


Retail sales in Canada likely rose by 0.7% from the previous month in March 2025, according to preliminary estimates. This comes after a 0.4% decline in February, bringing sales to C\$69.4 billion, in line with the initial estimate and marking the second consecutive month of declining retail sales. Sales were down in four of nine subsectors and were led by decreases at motor vehicle and parts dealers (-2.6%), with all four store categories in this subsector registering declines. On the other hand, the largest increases were seen for food and beverage retailers (+2.8%) and miscellaneous store retailers (+2.3%). Core retail sales, which exclude gasoline stations and fuel vendors and motor vehicle and parts dealers, were up 0.5% in February. Retail sales fell across seven provinces, with Nova Scotia (-2.6%) and Quebec (-0.9%) leading the declines, while Manitoba saw the largest increase (+1.8%). On a yearly basis, retail turnover surged 4.7% in February.

The year-ahead inflation expectations in the United States, as compiled by the University of Michigan, were revised slightly down to 6.5% in April 2025, from an earlier estimate of 6.7%, yet remained above March's 5%. It was the highest reading since November 1981. In the meantime, the five-year outlook was unrevised at 4.4% in April, the highest since June 1991, up from 4.1% in the previous month. The five-year outlook in the United States, as compiled by the University of Michigan, was unrevised at 4.4% in April 2025, the highest level since June 1991, up from 4.1% in the previous month. The five-year outlook in the United States are aged 3.20 percent from 1979 until 2025, reaching an all time high of 9.70 percent in February of 1980 and a record low of 2.20 percent in December of 2019.

Profits of China's industrial firms expanded by 0.8% yoy to CNY 1,509.36 billion in the first three months of 2025, recovering from a 0.3% drop in the first two months of the year, amid further stimulus measures from Beijing. Profits from foreign-invested enterprises and those from Hong Kong, Macao, and Taiwan grew by 2.8%, while profits from joint-stock enterprises edged up 0.1%. Additionally, private sector profits fell by 0.3%, much softer drops than a 9.0% plunge in the prior period. In contrast, profits of state-owned firms shrank by 1.4%, reversing a 2.1% rise previously. Among industries, profits rose in agriculture (40.3%), non-ferrous metal smelting (33.6%), heat production (6.1%), general manufacturing (9.5%), special equipment (14.2%), textiles (7.1%), computer and communications (3.2%), and electrical machinery (7.5%). Conversely, profits fell in coal mining (-47.7%), non-metallic minerals (-14.2%), automobiles (-6.2%), chemicals (-0.4%), and oil and gas extraction (-3.1%).

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
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#### 1. Movers and Shakers in S&P 300 >
