


The Aussie market started positive and faded to flat as markets were waiting for update from the US and China talks. The US announced the UK deal with no details on Friday, and the US market reacted similarly and closed flat. The update was that US will cut tariff to 30% and China will cut to 10% for 90 days to start negotiations. The rest are hopes and dreams. It was a clear win for China and a massive backflip for US. China said from the start that they won't start negotiations without big unilateral tariff cuts. US has delivered the massive tariff cuts to get China to negotiation table. Everyone knew that US can't keep it going and they folded with no real move by China after claiming that they won't. We are going to get the whole media spin of starting with 50% and going to 145% and coming back to 30% is "the art of deal". If the great deal is to become Manilla Folder at every point of pressure, the US is going to have a tough time. Bond market bullied US three times in one week and it's coming again. Cost of production in the US is so expensive that tariffs below 50% are not worth the effort. There is no angle where US is winning in the deal. China will keep the supply chains and will negotiate with all the cards. US is going to spin it in the media that they will get this and that, but they folded to Chinese demand with nothing. Inflation is going higher and US Fed rate cuts are going to fade away. Bond market is getting ready to charge again. It may be different this time!

CNBC on US and China tariff cuts > The U.S. and China on Monday agreed to suspend most tariffs on each other's goods in a move that shows a thawing of trade tensions between the world's two largest economies. "We had very productive talks and I believe that the venue, here in Lake Geneva, added great equanimity to what was a very positive process," U.S. Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent said in a news conference. "We have reached an agreement on a 90-day pause and substantially move down the tariff levels. Both sides on the reciprocal tariffs will move their tariffs down 115%," Bessent said. The deal means "reciprocal" tariffs between both countries will be cut from 125% to 10%. The U.S.' 20% duties on Chinese imports relating to fentanyl will remain in place, meaning total tariffs on China stand at 30%.

CNBC on US regulation on pharma and biotech > President Donald Trump said he will sign an executive order Monday morning to introduce "most favored nation" pricing model to lower U.S. prescription drug costs. "I am pleased to announce that Tomorrow morning, in the White House, at 9:00 A.M., I will be signing one of the most consequential Executive Orders in our Country's history. Prescription Drug and Pharmaceutical prices will be REDUCED, almost immediately, by 30% to 80%," Trump said in a post on Truth Social Sunday. The policy ties the amount the government pays for some medications to prices paid abroad. In other words, the U.S. would pay no more than the lowest prices paid by other wealthy countries.

The annual inflation rate in Brazil rose to 5.53% in April 2025 from 5.48% in the previous month, the highest since February 2023, to remain above the Central Bank of Brazil's upper target of 4.5% for sixth consecutive month. Consumer prices accelerated for food and non-alcoholic beverages (7.81% vs 7.68% in March), despite the Federal Government's removal of food tariffs in an attempt to tame inflation. Inflation also rose for housing and utilities (4.00% vs 3.84%), other personal spending (5.75% vs 5.28%), household goods and repairs (2.49% vs 1.69%), and clothing (4.01% vs 3.53%). On the other hand, inflation slowed for transportation (5.49% vs 6.05%). From the previous month, the Brazilian CPI rose by 0.43%.

In April 2025, Canada's unemployment rate climbed to 6.9% from 6.7% in the previous month, hitting its highest level in over three years since November of the previous year. This exceeded market expectations of 6.8%. The rise can be attributed to a significant increase in the number of jobless individuals, which reached 1,548,100 - a spike of 39,300. This signals that businesses may be starting to feel the impact of tariffs imposed by the United States. Despite this, net employment saw a modest increase of 7,500, slightly surpassing the expected 2,500. This helped to offset most of the 32,600 job losses from the previous month. The manufacturing sector was hit hardest, experiencing a net decline of 31,000 jobs due to high tariffs on aluminum, steel, and auto industries. However, despite this contraction, the labor force expanded, leading to an uptick in the labor force participation rate by 0.1 percentage points to 65.3%.


China's consumer prices dropped by 0.1% year-on-year in April 2025, maintaining the same pace for the second month and matching market expectations. It marked the third consecutive month of consumer deflation, weighed by the combined effects of ongoing trade tensions with the US, weak domestic demand, and persistent employment uncertainty. Non-food prices were flat after the prior 0.2% rise, as increases in housing (0.1% vs 0.1% in March), healthcare (0.2% vs 0.1%), and education (0.7% vs 0.8%) were offset by a sharper drop in transport cost (-3.9% vs -2.6%). On the food side, prices saw their smallest fall in three months, amid a sharp rebound in fresh food costs in the face of extreme weather, supply chain disruptions, and the impact of trade barriers. Core inflation, which excludes volatile food and fuel prices, rose 0.5%, holding steady for the second month. On a monthly basis, the CPI edged up 0.1%, reversing a 0.4% drop in March and recording the first increase in three months.


China's producer prices fell 2.7% yoy in April 2025, slightly underperforming market consensus of a 2.6% decline and after a 2.5% drop in March. This was the 31st straight month of producer deflation and the steepest pace since last October, driven by rising external risks from escalating trade tensions with the U.S. and persistently weak domestic demand. Cost of production materials fell further (-3.1% vs -2.8% in March), with sharper drops in mining (-9.4% vs -8.3%), raw materials (-3.6% vs -2.4%), and processing (-2.3% vs -2.6%). Consumer goods prices remained subdued (-1.6% vs -1.5%), pressured by clothing (-0.1% vs -0.3%), durable goods (-3.7% vs -3.4%), and food (-1.4% vs -1.4%), while prices for daily-use goods were little changed (0.6% vs 0.7%). On a monthly basis, producer prices slipped 0.4%, matching the March pace and staying at the largest drop in six months. For the first four months of the year, factory-gate prices shrank 2.4%, compared with a 2.3% drop in Q1 of 2025.

Japan's current account surplus rose to JPY 3,678.1 billion in March 2025 from JPY 3,447.8 billion a year earlier, broadly in line with market expectations. The goods account surplus expanded to JPY 516.5 billion from JPY 463.5 billion, as exports grew 1.8% year-on-year, outpacing the 1.3% rise in imports. The primary income surplus also increased notably to JPY 3,920.2 billion from JPY 3,607.4 billion. However, the services account deficit widened slightly to JPY 0.2 billion from JPY 0.05 billion, while the secondary income deficit grew to JPY 739.4 billion from JPY 618.6 billion. In February 2025, Japan posted a record current account surplus of JPY 4,061 billion. For the full fiscal year 2024, the surplus widened to JPY 30.38 trillion from JPY 26.17 trillion in the previous year, reflecting strong gains in primary income and resilient exports.

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
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1. Movers and Shakers in S&P 300 >
