
MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market started flat and faded all day to close negative despite a slight bounce after RBA update. RBA was cautious and supported a data driven approach to rate cycle. RBA started the rate cut cycle without data support and surprised the market by not cutting last week. It is tough to be a central bank. You are trying to do brain surgery with a butcher's knife. The timing is always going to be off, but they can't be way off the pace. The RBA chief said they were late to hiking and they did not hike as much. They expect to not go down as much as well. Despite all the economists forecasting a rate cut next month, it is not clear cut on the data yet. RBA expects Q2 inflation to be down, but monthly data suggest that it is rising. Then we have US trade wars. The trade war is mainly a pathway for Trump administration to pass a 10-15% GST on US consumers to claim that they are paying for the tax cut for the wealthy. The reality is that the tariff tax will cover only a small part of the tax cut such that the debt is expected to rise by \$5trill over the decade. The main 5 trading partners are looking like UK and Japan on 10%, China on 20% and the rest on 15% after the expected TACO (Trump Always Chickens Out). Technically, if everyone gets 10-20%, then there is no competitive change, but US consumers are the losers. Trump attack on US Fed is ramping up despite legally he can't do anything. Ironically, Trump is forcing US Fed to not cut rates. It may be different this time!

CNBC on US Trade War and Spanish Olive Oil > Spain's Deoleo, the world's largest olive oil producer, says U.S. President Donald Trump's threat to impose 30% tariffs on imports from the European Union could translate into higher prices for U.S. consumers — as well as limited access to a superfood staple. Trump has threatened to raise tariffs on the 27-member bloc from Aug. 1, in what would mark a steep jump from the current 10% duty. The EU has long been scrambling to reach a trade deal with the U.S. and is considering its options ahead of Trump's deadline, including the prospect of countermeasures. Huge uncertainty persists over whether the U.S. and EU can strike a deal over the coming days, although a blockbuster framework agreement between the U.S. and Japan has raised hopes of a breakthrough.

CNBC on Solid State EV > U.S. President Donald Trump will visit the Federal Reserve on Thursday, the White House said, escalating his pressure campaign against Chairman Jerome Powell. This is the first time in nearly two decades that an American president will be making an official trip to the central bank. American presidents have traditionally respected the independence of the central bank, which is insulated both in law and in practice from the political whims of elected officials. Trump's visit is a remarkable symbolic move on that independence, bringing his drumbeat of criticism over Powell's refusal to lower interest rates right to the chairman's doorstep. The White House released a schedule on Wednesday that said Trump would visit the Federal Reserve at 4:00 p.m. ET on Thursday.

Germany's GfK Consumer Climate Indicator slipped to -21.5 heading into August 2025 from -20.3 in the prior month, missing market consensus of -19.2 and marking the lowest print since April. The decline reflected growing consumer pessimism amid economic uncertainty, including concerns over U.S. tariffs on European goods. The propensity to save climbed to its highest since February 2024 (16.4 vs 13.9 in July), and willingness to buy fell for the second month in a row (-9.2 vs -6.2). Economic expectations also dropped sharply (10.1 vs 20.1), ending a five-month streak of increase. "The recovery in consumer sentiment continues to be postponed, because the willingness to save has risen again," said NIM consumer expert Rolf Buerkl, adding that general uncertainty, the need to prepare for difficult times, and high food prices were key factors. Still, income expectations improved for the fifth month, reaching a one-year high (15.2 vs 12.8), lifted by solid wage agreements and easing inflation.

The HCOB France Manufacturing PMI edged up to 48.4 in July 2025 from 48.1 in June, remained below the 50 threshold, indicating a continued contraction in the sector, according to preliminary estimates. Output showed a modest improvement, yet overall conditions remained fragile as new orders fell at the fastest pace since February, largely due to weakening export demand. Despite the subdued environment, factory employment rose marginally—the strongest pace in two-and-a-half years—as some firms brought in fixed-term staff. On the pricing front, factory gate prices ticked up following recent declines, offering slight relief and helping firms recover some of their lost margins. Looking ahead, business confidence among manufacturers dropped sharply to its lowest level since November 2024, amid mounting concerns over tighter budgets, a weaker sales outlook, and ongoing political uncertainty. Risks also remain elevated due to domestic austerity measures and global trade tensions.


The HSBC India Manufacturing PMI climbed to 59.2 in July 2025 from 58.4 in the previous month, according to preliminary estimates. The latest figure signaled a robust expansion in manufacturing activity and marked the highest reading in nearly 17-and-a-half years, highlighting the sector's continued momentum. Mirroring the strength in output, new orders also saw a strong increase, although the pace of growth in new export orders eased slightly, indicating some moderation in external demand. Meanwhile, the survey pointed to a sharp rise in purchasing activity, which led to a notable accumulation of input inventories, further supported by ongoing improvements in supplier delivery times. However, stocks of finished goods declined as manufacturers increasingly drew from existing inventories to fulfill strong demand. On the pricing front, charge inflation picked up pace, reflecting stronger pricing power among producers amid firm demand conditions.


The au Jibun Bank Japan Manufacturing PMI unexpectedly dropped to 48.8 in July 2025 from June's final reading of 50.1, which marked the first time in 13 months that the index exceeded the 50.0 threshold separating expansion from contraction, preliminary estimates showed. The latest figure missed market forecasts of 50.2 and marked the lowest level in three months. The downturn was driven by a renewed decline in output amid lingering uncertainty over US tariff policy and weak demand. New orders continued to fall, with export orders also declining, as businesses adopted a wait-and-see approach in response to ongoing trade tensions.

The S&P Global Flash Australia Services PMI Business Activity Index rose to 53.8 in July, up from 51.8 in June, due to accelerated business activity growth at the start of the third quarter, reaching its fastest pace in 16 months. This rise in services activity was a key driver behind the overall expansion in the private sector. New service orders increased sharply, supported by expanding customer bases and successful business development, contributing to the strongest inflow of new orders in over three years. Despite rising input costs, service providers raised their prices at a faster rate than in June, reflecting stronger cost inflation pressures. Export orders in services stabilized after months of decline, providing some relief amid broader challenges. While overall business sentiment remained positive, confidence eased to its lowest level since last November due to increased uncertainty.




