
MARKET COMMENTARY


The Aussie market started positively and faded to flat ahead of RBA update and ended up on a positive close after the expected rate cut. RBA downgraded outlook after cutting rates and flagged that they were data dependent. RBA is data dependent, but they select data to match the narrative they want to push. RBA did not cut to help the middle to low income because they were in a multiyear recession, and no one cared. RBA is cutting because the over leveraged vested interest groups are bleeding, and they will be in trouble if the property bubble fades like in US, UK and Canada. US delayed China tariffs as TACO Tuesday lived up to it's name and Trump backflipped on Intel CEO from resignation to successful. You have to wonder what he had to give up and for whom. Trump federalized Washington DC under the claim of crime when crime statistics in DC is better than most US states. We are in large scale distraction play to keep media away from Epstein and Israel mess. Israel is planning to take over Gaza completely as genocide was not extensive enough. US inflation is out tonight and that is key to US Fed cutting in Sep as expected. It may be different this time!

CNBC on US trade war > President Donald Trump on Monday delayed high U.S. tariffs on Chinese goods from snapping back into place for another 90 days, a White House official told CNBC. Those tariffs were set to resume Tuesday. But Trump signed an executive order hour beforehand that extends the deadline until mid-November, according to the official. The delay was the expected outcome from the latest round of talks between U.S. trade negotiators and their Chinese counterparts, which took place in Stockholm in late July. If the deadline were not extended, then U.S. duties on China would have shot back up to where they stood in April, when the tariff war between the world's largest trading nations was at its peak. At that time, Trump had cranked up blanket tariffs on Chinese imports to 145%, and China had retaliated with 125% duties on U.S. goods. But the two sides agreed to pause most of those tariffs in May, after negotiators met for the first time in Geneva. The U.S. pared its tariffs back to 30%, and China dropped its levies to 10%.

CNBC on Federal control of Washington DC > President Donald Trump on Monday placed the Washington, D.C., police department under federal control and deployed 800 National Guard troops in the capital city to address what he claimed was out-of-control crime there. It is the first time that a president has federalized the Metropolitan Police Department. Trump's move drew fierce condemnation from local officials, who noted that official statistics show crime in D.C. is on the decline. "I'm announcing a historic action to rescue our nation's capital from crime, bloodshed, bedlam and squalor, and worse," Trump said at the start of a news conference at the White House. "This is Liberation Day in D.C., and we're going to take our capitol back," he said. D.C. Attorney General Brian Schwalbe called Trump's actions "unprecedented, unnecessary, and unlawful," and signaled his office will take action to challenge the administration.

The United Kingdom's unemployment rate stood at 4.7% in the three months to June 2025, unchanged from the previous period as the market expected. The reading remained at its highest level since the three months ending July 2021, as the number of people unemployed for between 6 and 12 months and for over 12 months increased compared to the prior period. On an annual basis, the number of people unemployed for up to 6 months, between 6 and 12 months, and over 12 months all rose. Meanwhile, the number of employed individuals climbed by 238 thousand to 34.21 million, the highest since September 2024, driven by gains in full-time employment. The number of people holding second jobs also increased, now accounting for 3.9% of all employed individuals. Lastly, the economic inactivity rate was unchanged at 21%.

Singapore's economy grew 4.4% year-on-year in Q2 2025, up from an upwardly revised 4.1% in Q1, which marked the slowest pace in four quarters. The latest print was slightly above the flash data of 4.3%, as the manufacturing sector quickened (5.2% vs 4.7% in Q1), driven by gains across all clusters. Also, service activity gained momentum (4.3% vs. 3.8%), amid broad-based growth within the sector, notably in wholesale and retail trade, information & communications, and accommodation & food services. Further, construction output accelerated (6.0% vs 4.9%), lifted by rises in both public sector and private sector output. Quarterly, GDP grew 1.4%, rebounding from a 0.5% fall in Q1. Meanwhile, the trade ministry raised its 2025 growth forecast to 1.5%–2.5% from April's 0.0%–2.0% after stronger-than-expected H1 results, though it warned of downside risks. Despite a free-trade deal and a trade deficit with the U.S., Singapore still faces a 10% tariff under Washington's sweeping tariffs.


The annual inflation rate in Italy remained unchanged from the previous month at 1.7% in July of 2025, aligned with the preliminary estimate, and contrasting with the initial market expectations that it would ease to 1.5%. Consistently, the EU-harmonized inflation rate inched lower to 1.7% from 1.8% in the previous month, tying the lowest rate so far this year and remaining below the ECB's target of 2%, but above expectations of 1.6%. Inflation rose for both unprocessed (5.1% vs 4.2% in June) and processed (2.8% vs 2.7%) food, in addition to miscellaneous services (2.2% vs 1.6%) and transportation services (3.3% vs 2.9%). In turn, prices slowed for regulated energy (17.1% vs 22.6%) and recreational and cultural services (2.7% vs 3.2%). The core inflation rate, which excludes volatile and often exogenous fresh food and energy subindices, remained unchanged at 2%. From the previous month, the Italian CPI rose by 0.4%.


Indonesia's retail sales grew 1.3% year-on-year in June 2025, slowing from a 1.9% rise in the previous month but marking the second consecutive month of increase. Sales growth eased for food, beverages, and tobacco (2.4% vs 4.0% in May) and cultural and recreational goods (1.5% vs 4.7%). Turnover also weakened for automotive parts and accessories (-0.9% vs 1.6%), fuel (1.2% vs 5.3%), household appliances (-5.9% vs -5.8%), and information and communication equipment (-17.9% vs -27.4%). In contrast, clothing sales rose (1.4% vs -0.3%), registering the first increase in three months. On a monthly basis, retail sales edged down 0.2%, moderating from a 1.3% drop in May and posting the smallest decline in three months, supported by holiday-related spending and cash handouts from the government ahead of the new school year.

The Reserve Bank of Australia slashed its cash rate by 25bps to 3.6% at its August meeting, matching market expectations and bringing borrowing costs to their lowest since April 2023. The unanimous decision marks a cumulative 75bps reduction since the start of the year, reflecting a sharp slowdown in inflation from its 2022 peak, its return to the RBA's 2–3% target range, and a softer labour market. Despite easing cost pressures, the central bank remains cautious amid rising uncertainty in domestic and global conditions, including trade policies that could dampen growth. The RBA noted that monetary policy is well-positioned to respond to global developments. It also expects household consumption growth to recover as real incomes rise, though weak demand in some sectors is limiting firms' ability to pass on costs, posing a risk to momentum. Policymakers stressed they will remain data-driven, monitoring demand, inflation, labour markets, and financial conditions to guide future moves.


