
MARKET COMMENTARY


The Aussie market started strong positive and faded all day to finish flat. The market was starting to see through the vested interest groups' media spin about rate cuts when asset prices are all-time high, unemployment is historically low, and inflation is rising. Everyone can see that tarriflation is starting to flow through as inventories start to run out. Most expected it to play out after 6 months and that is exactly what we are seeing. Fed was open to rate cuts after weak employment data, but they remain data dependent. We are going to get another update of consumer and manufacturing inflations before the next US Fed meeting. The local reporting season continues to deliver volatility. ABB and ANN were the best while REH and EVT were the worst on market reaction to updates. Markets are paying up for winners despite the already multi decade high multiples while smashing misses despite those stocks already been smashed into the result. The global macro is going to wobble as US starts take-over of Chicago for political reasons and put new tariffs...now on furniture. The main problem is that global market's best-case scenario with current multiples at multi decade high is flat at best for the next decade. History suggests there will be pain coming because we will keep leveraging up till something breaks. It may be different this time!

CNBC — Ukraine War > Russian foreign minister Sergey Lavrov threw cold water on the possibility of an imminent meeting taking place between President Vladimir Putin and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy, saying that no meeting is currently planned. "Putin is ready to meet with Zelenskyy, when the agenda would be ready for a summit," Lavrov said during an interview with NBC News' "Meet the Press" that aired Sunday. "And this agenda is not ready at all," he continued. Lavrov's comments come after President Donald Trump suggested earlier this month that the leaders of the two countries had agreed to meet, which would mark a breakthrough in the ongoing war. "I called President Putin, and began the arrangements for a meeting, at a location to be determined, between President Putin and President Zelenskyy," Trump wrote on his Truth Social on Aug. 18, after he met separately with the two leaders.

CNBC – Employment Market > Millions of workers left their jobs during the "Great Resignation" of the Covid-19 pandemic, but economic insecurity and uncertainty have once more turned the tides of the labor market toward the "Great Stay." Economists coined the term to refer to fewer employees leaving jobs, and fewer employers hiring or firing new workers. "We had this 'Great Resignation' just a couple of years ago," Nela Richardson, chief economist at ADP, told CNBC. But now, "workers aren't going anywhere," she noted. "They've got their dream job, which is probably partly at home, maybe with a big salary pickup ... And what we actually see in the data is very low turnover, which is very unusual in the U.S.," she added.

Saudi Arabia's trade surplus widened to SAR 22.0 billion in June 2025, up from SAR 20.0 billion in the same month last year, marking the largest surplus since February. Exports rose by 3.7% yoy to SAR 92.1 billion, reaching a three-month high. The modest gain came despite a 2.5% decline in oil exports, which still accounted for 70.2% of total exports. In contrast, non-oil exports surged by 22.1%, helping offset the weakness in oil trade. China remained the top destination for Saudi exports, making up 15.5% of the total, followed by the UAE (9.1%) and India (9.1%). On the import side, total imports increased by 1.7% to SAR 70.0 billion, driven by a 29.0% surge in purchases of machinery, electrical equipment, and parts, which accounted for 30.6% of all imports. Meanwhile, imports of transportation equipment and parts dropped by 13.2%, comprising 12.5% of the total. Among major import sources, China held the largest share at 27.9%, followed by the US (8.3%) and the UAE (6.2%).

Singapore's annual inflation rate slowed to 0.6% in July 2025 from 0.8% in the previous month and slightly below market forecasts of 0.7%. The latest figure marked the lowest reading since January 2021, mainly due to lower prices for clothing and footwear (-2.3% vs -2.2% in June), information and communications (-2.6% vs -2.4%), and miscellaneous goods and services (-0.4% vs 0%). Additionally, inflation moderated for housing and utilities (0.3% vs 0.9%) and health (2.4% vs 2.8%). On the other hand, costs increased for food (1.1% vs 1%) and education (0.7% vs 0.5%), while it declined at a slower pace for recreation, sport, and culture (-1.2% vs -2.6%). On a monthly basis, consumer prices fell by 0.4%, the sharpest in six months, deepening from a 0.1% decline in the preceding period. Meanwhile, the annual core inflation rate eased to 0.5% in July, the lowest in four months, missing market estimates and the prior month's 0.6% increase.


Japan's leading economic index—which reflects the economic outlook for the coming months based on indicators such as job offers and consumer sentiment—was revised lower to 105.6 in June 2025, down from the preliminary estimate of 106.1. However, the latest reading remained above May's figure of 104.8 and marked the highest level since March. The increase was mainly driven by a surge in household spending in May, which recorded the fastest growth since August 2022, reflecting the impact of government measures aimed at boosting domestic consumption. Consumer sentiment also hit a four-month high in June, while the unemployment rate held steady at 2.5%, despite a decline in total employment.

Foreign direct investment (FDI) in China dropped 13.4% year-on-year to CNY 467.34 billion in the first seven months of 2025, amid global economic uncertainty. By sector, the manufacturing industry attracted CNY 121.04 billion, while the services sector accounted for a larger share at CNY 336.25 billion. High-tech industries remained a bright spot, drawing CNY 137.36 billion in actual foreign investment. Within that segment, e-commerce services surged 146.8%, aerospace and equipment manufacturing rose 42.2%, chemical pharmaceutical manufacturing grew 37.4%, and medical equipment and device manufacturing increased 25.5%. From a regional perspective, ASEAN investment rose 1.1%, while Switzerland, Japan, and the UK recorded sharp gains of 63.9%, 53.7%, and 19.5%, respectively. Despite the overall decline, foreign interest in China's high-tech sectors remained robust, highlighting continued investor focus on advanced industries.

Retail sales in Canada are expected to have slumped by 0.8% from the previous month in July of 2025, according to a preliminary estimate. This would reflect the second sharpest drop in over one year, aligning with the volatile swings in retail as uncertain trade policy from the US impacted consumer patterns. In July, retail sales jumped by 1.5% to C\$70.2 billion, the sharpest increase so far this year, and revised marginally lower than the preliminary estimate of a 1.6% jump. Core retail sales jumped by 1.9%, supported by higher turnover for beverage retailers (2.3%), supermarkets (1.8%), and clothing and accessories retailers (5.1%). In turn, turnover was also higher in gasoline stations (1.8%) despite the softer prices, as volumes soared by 2.7%.


