MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market starts the new week on a negative note as US on-again off-again trade war with China rattles markets. US announced 100% tariffs on China on Friday night and then walked it back over the weekend and suggested TACO (Trump Always Chickens Out) trade. Then finished the weekend saying the tariffs were coming on Nov 1st but they are supposedly talking. US and China are only talking through media for spin while China is now in a better shape than US. They have been diversifying away from US controlled supply over the last decade as multiple presidents have pushed supply restrictions on China. US putting 100% tariff on China was always unsustainable at the best of times. US government is in shutdown mode to hide weak economic data and releasing Epstein files. US Fed delivered a cut as insurance against government policy failures. The US government shutdown is unlikely to be resolved soon because Democrats have framed it as a fight for food and health while Republicans are struggling with illegals are claiming health benefit when they are legally not allowed to. China has stocked up and prepared for trade war while US is fueling domestic social unrest to distract from economic weakness. It may be different this time!

CNBC – China and Netherlands > The Dutch government has taken control of Nexperia, a Chinese-owned semiconductor maker based in the Netherlands, in an extraordinary move to ensure a sufficient supply of its chips remains available in Europe amid rising global trade tensions. Nexperia, a subsidiary of China's Wingtech Technology, specializes in the high-volume production of chips used in automotive, consumer electronics and other industries, making it vital for maintaining Europe's technological supply chains. On Sunday evening, the Dutch Minister of Economic Affairs revealed that it had invoked the "Goods Availability Act" on the company in September in order "to prevent a situation in which the goods produced by Nexperia (finished and semi-finished products) would become unavailable in an emergency." Following the announcement from the Hague, Wingtech plunged its maximum daily limit of 10% on the Shanghai Stock Exchange.

CNBC – China's exports climbed at the fastest pace in six months in September, while imports logged their strongest gain in more than a year, even as a trade deal with the U.S. remains elusive. Exports grew 8.3% in September in U.S. dollar terms from a year earlier, China's customs data showed Monday, beating Reuters-polled economists' estimates for a 7.1% rise and rebounding from August's six-month low. Imports jumped 7.4% last month from a year ago, sharply beating Reuters' estimates for a 1.5% growth, marking the strongest level since April 2024, according to LSEG data. Tensions between Beijing and Washington have flared again in recent days as both sides traded barbs and ramped up respective restrictions, threatening to erode progress made after several rounds of bilateral trade talks this year.

The University of Michigan consumer sentiment for the US came in at 55 in October 2025, compared to 55.1 in September and forecasts of 54.2, preliminary estimates showed. Consumer sentiment was virtually unchanged from September, as improvements in current personal finances and year-ahead business conditions were offset by declines in expectations for future personal finances as well as current buying conditions for durables. The current economic conditions subindex increased to 61 from 60.4 while the expectations gauge edged down to 51.2 from 51.7. Overall, consumers perceive very few changes in the outlook for the economy from last month. Meanwhile, year-ahead inflation expectations edged down to 4.6% from 4.7% while long-run inflation expectations held steady at 3.7%.

The year-ahead inflation expectations in the United States, as compiled by the survey of the University of Michigan, eased for the second month to 4.6% in October 2025, from 4.7% in September, according to preliminary figures. Meanwhile, the five-year inflation outlook stood at 3.7% in October, matching September's reading. Michigan 5 Year Inflation Expectations in the United States averaged 3.20 percent from 1979 until 2025, reaching an all-time high of 9.70 percent in February of 1980 and a record low of 2.20 percent in December of 2019.


The annual inflation rate in Russia fell for a sixth straight month to 8% in September 2025 from 8% in the previous month, the softest rate since April of 2024. The development was in line with the Bank of Russia's forecast that inflationary pressures were unlikely to remain at the elevated level from the first half of the year, but price growth still held well above the central bank's 4% target. Prices rose at a softer pace for food items (9.5% vs 9.8% in August), while inflation was steady for non-food goods (at 3.9%) and services (at 11.1%). In the meantime, core inflation eased to 7.7% from 8%. From the previous month, consumer prices increased by 0.3%, after a 0.4% fall in August.


Canada's unemployment rate held steady at 7.1% in September 2025, slightly below market expectations of 7.2% but remaining at its highest level since August 2021. The number of unemployed people rose by 11,900 (+0.7%) to 1.61 million, while employment increased by 60,400 (+0.3%) to 21.02 million, easily surpassing forecasts for a modest 5,000 gain and partly offsetting a 106,000 (-0.5%) decline over the previous two months. Full-time employment rose sharply by 106,100 (+0.6%), whereas part-time jobs fell by 45,600 (-1.2%). The employment rate edged up 0.1 percentage point to 60.6%, marking the first increase in three months, while the labor force participation rate also ticked higher by 0.1 point to 65.2%. Canada's average hourly wages increased by 3.3% year-on-year to C\$36.78 in September 2025, following growth of 3.2% in August. Average Hourly Earnings in Canada averaged 24.54 CAD from 1997 until 2025, reaching an all-time high of 37.81 CAD in August of 2025 and a record low of 15.88 CAD in January of 1997.

China's trade surplus came in at USD 90.45 billion in September, below expectations of USD 98.96 billion but above the USD 81.69 billion recorded in the same month last year, as exports continued to outpace imports. Exports rose 8.3% yoy, beating forecasts for a 6% gain and accelerating from a 4.4% increase in August. This marked the fastest pace of export growth since March, as Chinese producers continued to diversify into new markets beyond the US. Imports grew by 7.4%, above expectations for a 1.5% rise and well above the 1.3% gain in August—marking the fastest import growth since April 2024, supported by stronger domestic demand ahead of the Golden Week holidays. China's trade surplus with the US rose to USD 22.82 billion in September, up from USD 20.32 billion in August, even as both exports to and imports from the US fell by 27.0% and 16.1%, respectively. Year-to-date, China posted a total trade surplus of USD 875.1 billion, with exports up 6.1% yoy, while imports fell by 1.1%.




