


The Aussie market was sliding all day, and RBA update did not help. RBA update was higher inflation for longer and employment remains strong. RBA rate cut expectations are going to get watered down and they should be. Market was expecting RBA to cut like we were in an economic collapse when we are sitting on all time high asset bubbles with historically low unemployment. RBA should have never moved into the rate cut cycle when you have solid employment and rampant asset prices. As usual, RBA has delivered another policy failure and that has sucked in more borrowers with expectations of a lot more cuts. Government fueled that problem with 5% deposit for FHB. Globally the economic mess continues while global passive funds are pushing up the AI bubble to give the perception that all is good. The latest news is that Amazon gave OpenAI some gift certificates to improve their revenue while OpenAI can claim that AI bubble is good. Soon OpenAI, Nvidia, Microsoft and Amazon will become their own customers by default. And then we can have unlimited growth...may be not. Bitcoin bits four-month low. It may be different this time!

CNBC – RBA on hold > Australia's central bank now sees core inflation staying stubbornly above its target band out to the middle of 2026 as consumer demand and house prices pick up faster than expected, seemingly limiting room for further cuts in interest rates. The Reserve Bank of Australia was widely expected to hold rates at 3.60% on Tuesday as an uncomfortably high reading on third-quarter inflation crushed any hopes of a cut. It had eased policy three times this year in February, May and August. In its quarterly Statement on Monetary Policy, the RBA said recent data — including stronger economic growth, sticky inflation and a still tight labor market — suggested there was less capacity in the economy than previously thought. "These indicators paint a mixed picture of financial conditions, consistent with policy now being close to neutral estimates - indeed, the cash rate is now below some models' central estimates of the neutral rate," said the RBA. It now expects underlying inflation — a trimmed mean measure closely watched by the RBA - to accelerate to 3.2% by the end of the year, from the current 3%.

CNBC – Open AI and Amazon > OpenAI has signed a deal to buy \$38 billion worth of capacity from Amazon Web Services, its first contract with the leader in cloud infrastructure and the latest sign that the \$500 billion artificial intelligence startup is no longer reliant on Microsoft. Under the agreement announced on Monday, OpenAI will immediately begin running workloads on AWS infrastructure, tapping hundreds of thousands of Nvidia's graphics processing units (GPUs) in the U.S., with plans to expand capacity in the coming years. Amazon stock closed 4% higher on Monday, a record closing high for the stock. The e-commerce giant is up 14% over the last two trading days, the best two-day period since Nov 2022. The first phase of the deal will use existing AWS data centers, and Amazon will eventually build out additional infrastructure for OpenAI.

Historically, 75% of retail investors have experienced losses during positive market periods. The HCOB Eurozone Manufacturing PMI was confirmed at 50.0 in October 2025, up slightly from 49.8 in September, signaling a stabilization in the sector following a modest deterioration the previous month. The reading reflected an eighth consecutive period of slight output growth, while new orders remained largely stagnant. Demand for euro area goods remains subdued; over the past three and a half years, it has increased in just one month—August 2025. New export orders continued to weigh on factory sales, declining for the fourth consecutive month. Employment levels continued to fall, extending the current sequence of job losses to nearly two and a half years. Inventories also declined, with both production inputs and finished goods decreasing, prolonging a long-running period of destocking.

The S&P Global Canada Manufacturing PMI rose to 49.6 in October from 47.7 in September, signalling only a marginal deterioration and the slowest contraction since January. Output and new orders both fell at much weaker rates, with production down only fractionally and new orders slipping to their weakest pace so far this year. Tariffs and volatile trade policies remained the main constraint, hitting export sales, delaying customs and keeping input costs elevated. Employment registered a marginal fall as firms continued not to replace leavers, with job losses easing to a much softer pace than earlier in the year. Input cost inflation stayed elevated and rose considerably amid tariff-related price pressures, while firms were more able to raise selling prices than in September as output price inflation picked up from an 11 month low. Looking ahead, confidence improved to its highest level since January but remained below trend as unpredictable trade policy continued to cloud the outlook.


The ISM US Manufacturing PMI fell to 48.7 in October 2025 from 49.1 in September, below market forecasts of 49.5, indicating an eighth consecutive month of contraction in the manufacturing sector. Production shrank (48.2 vs 51) and further contractions were also seen in new orders (49.4 vs 48.9), inventories (45.8 vs 47.7) and backlog of orders (47.9 vs 46.2). Employment continued to decline (46 vs 45.3), with 67% of panelists indicating that managing head count is still the norm at their companies, as opposed to hiring. Meanwhile, price pressures eased (58 vs 61.9) while the supplier deliveries index indicated slower delivery performance for the third consecutive month (54.2 vs 52.6). "Of the six largest manufacturing industries, only two (Food, Beverage & Tobacco Products; and Transportation Equipment) expanded in October," said Susan Spence, Chair of the ISM.

South Korea's consumer prices rose 2.4% year-on-year in October 2025, surpassing market expectations of a 2.1% gain as a weaker won pushed up energy and food costs, strengthening the case for a rate hold by the central bank. The reading accelerated from September's 2.1% and marked the highest level since July 2024. Price increases were most notable for miscellaneous goods & services (4.3%), food & non-alcoholic beverages (3.5%), transport (3.4%), restaurants & hotels (3.2%), and furnishings, household equipment & routine maintenance (2.2%). The data underscores policymakers' cautious stance after keeping rates unchanged for a third consecutive month in October, balancing growth support with efforts to contain inflation expectations. On a monthly basis, consumer prices rose 0.3%, moderating from a 0.5% increase in September but exceeding the forecast of 0%.

The Reserve Bank of Australia kept its cash rate unchanged at 3.6% during its November 2025 meeting, in line with market consensus and maintaining borrowing costs at their lowest since April 2023. The central bank noted that inflation has eased sharply from its 2022 peak, despite a temporary uptick in September. The board assumes one more rate cut in 2026, with underlying inflation expected to rise above 3% in the near term before moderating to around 2.6% by 2027. Policymakers highlighted ongoing uncertainty in both domestic and global outlooks, including stronger-than-expected private demand that could tighten labor markets and fuel inflation, and a slowdown that could weigh on growth. Globally, elevated geopolitical and trade tensions remain risks despite upward revisions to world growth forecasts. Financial conditions have eased, but the full impact of earlier cuts will take time. The RBA remains cautious and data-dependent, closely monitoring inflation, demand, and labor trends.




