
MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market started the new week on a slightly negative day. The market is trying to digest the extreme market multiple against US policy uncertainty. US keeps taking steps to attack Venezuela for regime change to give vested interest access to oil reserves while China is moving to defend their trade benefits. If US does follow through, then China has free pass to take Taiwan. US is running the Russian deal to Ukraine and is surprised that they turned it down. The main game is central banks. US Fed is key to sentiment and there is a lot of uncertainty attached to them. JPow is expected to be replaced by Hassett but that will be the end of Fed independence. Will JPow deliver the expected rate cut? Will he stay the full cycle? Will he push back and defend independence? No one really knows and since the data is two months old, he can stay on hold till data comes. On the flip side, RBA should be hiking when you use their own logic to cutting proactively. But they won't. RBA will be on hold for a while now. It may be different this time!

CNBC – China > China's U.S. bound goods fell for an eighth straight month despite a recent trade deal between the two economies, even as overall exports surpassed market expectations in November as manufacturers loaded up shipments to other markets. Outbound shipments surged 5.9% last month in U.S. dollar terms from a year earlier, China's customs data showed Monday, topping economists' forecast for a 3.8% growth in a Reuters poll. That growth marked a rebound from an unexpected 1.1% drop in October — the first contraction since March 2024. Imports rose 1.9% last month, missing expectations for a 3% rise, as a protracted housing downturn and rising job insecurity continued to be drag on domestic consumption. Growth was higher compared to 1% in October. Chinese officials have renewed pledges to expand imports and work toward balancing trade amid widespread criticism against its aggressive exports.

CNBC — Asia > The proportion of volume from suppliers in China, Hong Kong, and Korea has declined from 90% to 50% over the past decade, reflecting a long-term diversification of supply chains that picked up steam during the first Trump administration and trade war, according to an analysis from Wells Fargo Supply Chain From 2018 to 2020, the supplier diversification away from China nearly doubled after the first tariff actions," said Jeremy Jansen, head of global originations at Wells Fargo Supply Chain Finance. He said since the first trade war, the gradual increase in supply chain diversification away from China to the South Asia Pacific region has steadily grown. "Based on our supplier counts, diversification is now 50/50 between the northern Asia Pacific region and the Southern," Jansen said. "The migration of midsize suppliers can be tracked into Taiwan, Vietnam, Indonesia, Thailand, India, and Malaysia," he added.bImports from China to the U.S. have dropped by 26 percent year-over-year, according to data from freight intelligence firm SONAR, but trade volumes from China to the South Asia Pacific region have significantly increased.

China's foreign exchange reserves climbed by USD 3.0 billion to USD 3.346 trillion in November 2025, up from USD 3.343 trillion in October and compared with market expectations of USD 3.36 trillion. It was the fourth straight month of increases, marking the highest level since November 2015, amid a weaker US dollar. The yuan dropped 0.65% against the dollar last month, while the dollar weakened 0.24% against a basket of other major currencies. Meanwhile, the People's Bank of China continued to add to its gold holdings for the thirteenth consecutive month, with reserves edging up to 74.12 million fine troy ounces in November from 74.09 million in October. The value of gold reserves rose to USD 310.65 billion from USD 297.21 billion a month earlier.


Japan's nominal wages rose 2.6% year-on-year in October 2025, the strongest increase in three months and above market expectations of 2.2%. However, wage growth continued to lag behind price increases for the tenth straight month as inflation kept outpacing pay gains. Real wages, a key gauge of household purchasing power, fell 0.7% in October from a year earlier as living costs climbed 3.4%, eroding workers' disposable income. Base salaries and overtime posted modest increases, while special bonuses jumped 6.7%, though such payments tend to be seasonal and less reliable as a sustained income boost. The data adds pressure on the Bank of Japan ahead of its December policy meeting, with speculation building that policymakers may opt for another rate hike.

Japan's GDP contracted 0.6% qoq in Q3 2025, deeper than the flash estimate of a 0.4% decline and market forecasts for a 0.5% drop. The latest figure followed a downwardly revised 0.5% growth in Q2 and marked the first quarterly contraction since Q1 2024, with business spending slipping for the first time in three quarters (-0.2%, compared with the flash estimate of a 1.0% gain and missing forecasts for a 0.4% growth, after a 1.3% rise in Q2). The weaker reading highlighted ongoing pressure from higher borrowing costs. Private consumption remained soft, edging up 0.2%, slightly above both the preliminary estimate and consensus of 0.1%, but slower than a 0.3% rise in Q2. Government spending also eased (0.2%, compared with the flash reading of 0.5% and after a 0.3% rise previously). Net trade added further drag (-0.2ppts), with exports (-1.2% vs 2.3% in Q2) falling faster than imports (-0.1% vs 1.3%) after Washington imposed a 15% baseline tariff on most Japanese goods in September.

China's trade surplus widened to USD 111.68 billion in November, up from USD 97.33 billion in the same month last year and surpassing expectations of USD 100.2 billion. It marked the largest trade surplus since June, as exports rose more than imports. Exports increased 5.9% year-on-year, beating forecasts for a 3.8% rise and rebounding from a 1.1% fall in October, as firms rushed to move inventory to take advantage of a fresh tariff truce with the US. In November, the US and China agreed to scale back some of their tariffs and a raft of other measures after US President Donald Trump and Chinese President Xi Jinping met in South Korea on October 30. Imports grew 1.9%, below expectations for a 2.8% rise but above the 1.0% gain in October. China's trade surplus with the US declined to USD 23.74 billion in November, down from USD 24.76 billion in October. Year-to-date, China recorded a total trade surplus of USD 1.08 trillion, with exports advancing 5.4% while imports dropped 0.6%.




