
MARKET COMMENTARY


The Aussie market has delivered three consecutive negative days as markets digest the global fiscal policy mistakes against monetary policy bailouts. RBA has been forced to move to hold with a data reality of hike outlook while US Fed is stuck in a cut with hawkish uncertainty. RBA has a clean-cut pathway to policy outlook with rising inflation and strong employment and solid consumer spending. US Fed on the other hand is dealing with a White House that keeps delivering policy failures and yet claims a win. Tariffs have been a disaster for US and their main trading partners. The gradual TACO (Trump Always Chickens Out) has left most of their close allies under more tariffs than their main target in China. The latest is Chip TACO where US reversed the restriction to allow the latest chips to be sold to China. The problem is the AI bubble is unwinding without China sales but China does not want them. They want to use their own AI chips and so far have done as well as the US mega techs. It is all about US Fed tonight and the White House is on all out attack. The rate cut is locked in. It is all about JPow and his outlook and what he is going to do till the end of his term in May 2026. JPow is bigger than Nvidia for the markets tonight. It may be different this time!

CNBC – China > China's consumer inflation climbed in November to hit its highest level in nearly two years, while producer price deflation deepened, underscoring the challenge policymakers face in reviving domestic demand amid persistent trade tensions. Consumer prices edged up 0.7% from a year earlier, its highest level since February last year, National Bureau of Statistics data showed Wednesday. The increase followed a 0.2% rise in October and matched the 0.7% gain expected in a Reuters poll of economists. Factory-gate prices fell 2.2% in November from a year earlier, largely because of a higher comparison base, missing the forecast of a 2% decline and extending the deflationary stretch into its fourth year The decline followed a 2.1% fall in October.

CNBC – US Fed > On Wednesday stateside, the U.S. Federal Reserve is widely expected to lower its benchmark interest rates by a quarter percentage point to a range of 3.5%-3.75%. However, given that traders are all but certain that the cut will happen — an 88.6% chance, to be exact, according to the CME FedWatch tool — the news is likely already priced into stocks by the market. That means any whiff of restraint could weigh on equities. In fact, the talk in the markets is that the Fed might deliver a "hawkish cut": lower rates while suggesting it could be a while before it cuts again. The "dot plot," or a projection of where Fed officials think interest rates will end up over the next few years, will be the clearest signal of any hawkishness. Investors will also parse Chair Jerome Powell's press conference and central bankers' estimates for U.S. economic growth and inflation to gauge the Fed's future rate path. In other words, the Fed could rein in market sentiment even if it cuts rates.

Historically, 75% of retail investors have experienced losses during positive market periods. Japan's producer prices rose 2.7% year-on-year in November 2025, unchanged from October and in line with market expectations. Cost continued to increase for most components: transport equipment (1.6% vs 1.5% in October), beverages and foods (4.9% vs 4.9% 5.0%), general-purpose machinery (2.7% vs 2.5%), other manufacturing (2.3% vs 2.6%), non-ferrous metals (14.9% vs 11.9%), electrical machinery (2.3% vs 1.7%), production machinery (3.6% vs 2.5%), metal products (0.1% vs 0.7%), plastics (0.3% vs 1.2%), information and communications (1.5% vs 0.3%), and business-oriented machinery (0.7% vs 0.8%). On the other hand, prices fell further for chemicals (-3.6% vs -3.8%), iron and steel (-6.8% vs -7.1%), and petroleum and coal products (-2.6% vs -0.8%). On a monthly basis, producer inflation increased 0.3%, also matching forecasts but easing from an upwardly revised 0.5% rise in the previous month.

Mexico's annual inflation accelerated to 3.80% in November 2025 from 3.57% in October, the highest since June and above expectations of 3.69%. Price pressures increased for food and non-alcoholic beverages (3% vs 2.64%), clothing and footwear (2.76% vs 2.30%), furniture, appliances and maintenance (3.59% vs 2.86%), transport (1.98% vs 1.35%), recreation and culture (4.48% vs 4.21%), and restaurants and hotels (7.62% vs 7.48%). Mild deflation persisted in insurance and financial services, though less sharply (-0.04% vs -0.84%). Inflation eased for alcoholic beverages and tobacco (3.44% vs 4.62%) and for housing and utilities (3.43% vs 3.68%). Month-on-month, consumer prices rose 0.66%, up from 0.36% in October. Core inflation quickened to 4.43%, the highest since March 2024.


Germany's trade surplus widened to €16.9 billion in October 2025, up from €15.3 billion in September and surpassing expectations of €15.2 billion. Exports unexpectedly edged up 0.1% to a six-month high of €131.3 billion, beating expectations of a 0.2% decline, supported by stronger demand from EU trading partners, where exports rose 2.7%, including gains of 2.5% to the euro area and 3.1% to non-euro-area countries. By contrast, shipments to third countries dropped 3.3%, including a 7.8% fall in exports to the US, Germany's largest export destination, amid the lingering impact of US tariffs, after an 11.9% surge in September. Shipments also fell to the UK and China. Imports unexpectedly fell 1.2% to €114.5 billion, missing forecasts of a 0.2% increase, weighed down by lower purchases from third countries, including China, the US, the UK, and Russia.

China's annual inflation rate picked up to 0.7% in November 2025 from 0.2% in the prior month, aligning with market consensus and marking the highest level since February 2024. Food prices rose for the first time in ten months (0.2% vs -2.9% in October), supported by rebounds in prices of fresh vegetables and fresh fruit, coupled with a less steep drop in pork. Also, non-food inflation increased further (0.8% vs 0.9%), lifted by the ongoing consumer trade-in programs. Prices continued to rise for clothing (1.9% vs 1.7%), healthcare (1.6% vs 1.4%), and education (0.8% vs 0.9%). Meantime, housing prices were flat after edging up 0.1% previously, while transport costs fell further (-2.3% vs -1.5%). Core inflation, which excludes food and energy, rose 1.2% yoy, matching October's pace and remaining at its highest level in 20 months. On a monthly basis, consumer prices fell 0.1%, missing forecasts for a 0.2% rise and after a 0.2% gain in October, marking the first drop in five months.

China's producer prices fell 2.2% year-on-year in November 2025, slightly accelerating from a 2.1% decline in October and marking the 38th consecutive month of contraction. The result came in slightly worse than market expectations of a 2.0% decline, reflecting ongoing price competition and persistently weak domestic demand. Consumer goods prices declined at a faster pace in November (-1.5% vs -1.4% in October), driven by steeper falls in durable goods (-3.6% vs -3.2%), while food (-1.5% vs -1.6%) and clothing (-0.3% vs -0.3%) continued to drop modestly. In contrast, costs of daily-use goods rose slightly faster (1.1% vs 1.0%). Meanwhile, production material prices remained weak (-2.4% vs -2.4%), with persistent declines in mining (-6.1% vs -7.8%), raw materials (-2.9% vs -2.5%), and processing (-1.9% vs -1.9%). During the first eleven months of the year, producer prices shrank 2.7%. Monthly, the PPI inched up 0.1%, the same pace as in October.




