
MARKET COMMENTARY


The Aussie market had the worst day in three weeks after US market had panic selling on Friday. US economy is in trouble while White House is attacking the Fed and Venezuela. Trump wants rates below 1% and is willing to pick the Fed chief to deliver it. The problem is the Fed has lost control of the cost of debt to the bond market. Like RBA, bond yields are higher now in Australia and US than what it was when they started the rate cuts. The social unrest is spreading around the world as economic slowdown bites the middle to low income. China delivered weaker economic data, but it is in no mood to ramp up stimulus when trade wars are restarting. Mexico and EU are looking to tariff China on the back of US pressure and that means more weakness. China is curbing steel export and that means demand for coking coal and iron ore are likely to take a hit. All time high copper on supply demand is likely to get a reality check while gold is only going higher. You are in gold or you are underperforming in 2025. It may be different this time!

CNBC — China > China's economic slowdown deepened in November with consumption, investment and industrial output growth falling short of expectations, as authorities sought to curb supply while struggling to revive demand and arrest the property sector decline. Retail sales rose 1.3% last month from a year earlier, sharply missing Reuters' median forecast for 2.8% growth, and slowing from 2.9% rise in the prior month. Industrial production climbed 4.8% in November from a year ago, missing expectations for a 5% jump and marking its weakest growth since August 2024. Investment in fixed assets, which include property, contracted 2.6% over the January through November period compared with a year earlier, sharper than the 2.3% drop estimated by economists. That decline deepened from 1.7% in the January to October period, and was the sharpest slump seen since the pandemic outbreak in 2020, according to data from Wind Information going back to 1992.

CNBC – US > The U.S. is planning to impose social media inspections on some tourists as President Donald Trump continues to ramp up travel restrictions for foreign visitors. Tourists — including those from Britain, Australia, France, and Japan — will be mandated to provide five years of their social media history as part of their applications to visit the U.S., according to a notice posted by U.S. Customs and Border Protection, or CBP, on Wednesday. The proposal, which has been given a 60 day-notice with requests for comments from the public, is not final and may see some revisions. Tourists from nations that are included in the U.S.' Visa Waiver Program can apply to the Electronic System for Travel Authorization, or ESTA, to visit the country for 90 days or less, with a fee of \$40. The social media check will now form a "mandatory data element" as part of the ESTA application.

The Bank of Japan's sentiment index for large manufacturers edged up to 15 in Q4 2025 from 14 in Q3, improving for a third quarter and marking the highest print since Q4 2021, amid the yen's sustained weakness and firm global demand, notably from the AI sector. The latest reading matched market estimates, with confidence remaining upbeat among firms producing lumber & wood (0 vs -8 in Q3), pulp (34 vs 26), petroleum (33 vs 0), iron & steel (-11 vs -14), food & drinks (9 vs 6), chemicals (22 vs 15), electrical machinery (17 vs 16), shipbuilding (41 vs 36), and processed metals (8 vs 0). At the same time, sentiment stayed stable for textiles (at 4), general-purpose machinery (at 27), and production machinery (at 17), but fell for motor vehicles (9 vs 10), and business-oriented machinery (13 vs 22). Large firms planned to lift capital expenditure by 12.6% in Q4, after a 12.5% rise in Q3, topping forecasts of 12%. This was the strongest rise in investment intentions in eight quarters. Non-Manufacturing PMI in Japan remained unchanged at 34 points in the fourth quarter of 2025, the same as in the previous two quarters, below market forecasts of 35. Non Manufacturing PMI in Japan averaged 7.26 points from 1983 until 2025, reaching an all time high of 57 points in the third quarter of 1990 and a record low of -41 points in the fourth quarter of 1998.

China's new home prices across 70 cities dropped 2.4% year-on-year in November 2025, deepening from a 2.2% decline in the previous two months. The latest reading marked the 29th consecutive month of price declines and the steepest pace since August, underscoring Beijing's ongoing struggle to counter the prolonged weakness in the property sector. Prices fell at a quicker pace in Beijing (-2.1% vs. -2.0% in October), Guangzhou (-4.3% vs. -4.2%), Shenzhen (-3.7% vs. -2.6%), Chongqing (-2.9% vs. -2.6%), and Tianjin (-2.2% vs. -1.5%). Meanwhile, costs in Shanghai eased (5.1% vs 5.7%). On a monthly basis, prices were 0.4% lower, after a 0.5% fall in October.


China's industrial production expanded 4.8% year-on-year in November 2025, easing slightly from a 4.9% increase in the previous month and below market expectations of 5.0%. This marked the softest increase since August 2024, due to softer rises in manufacturing activity (4.6% vs 4.9% in October) and electricity, heat, gas, and water (4.3% vs 5.4%). Meanwhile, production of mining accelerated (6.3% vs 4.5%). Within manufacturing, 30 of 41 major industries registered growth, including automotive (11.9%), computers and communications (9.2%), railway and shipbuilding (11.9%), ferrous metal smelting and rolling (0.9%), nonferrous metal smelting and rolling (4.8%), chemical products (6.7%), coal mining and washing (7.5%), oil and gas (5.1%), heat production (4.2%), textiles (1.8%), and food manufacturing (1.7%). For the first eleven months of the year, industrial production increased by 6.0%. On a monthly basis, industrial output rose by 0.44%.

China's retail sales rose 1.3% year-on-year in November 2025, easing from October figures and market estimates of 2.9%. It marked the slowest yearly rise since December 2022 despite ongoing consumer subsidy programs from Beijing. Sales eased for grains, oil, and food (6.1% vs 9.1% in October), sports and entertainment goods (0.4% vs 10.1%), clothing, shoes, hats, and textiles (3.5% vs 6.3%), cosmetics (6.1% vs 9.6%), gold, silver, and jewelry (8.5% vs 37.6%), office supplies (11.7% vs 13.5%), and communication equipment (20.6% vs 23.2%). At the same time, turnover fell further for household appliances and audiovisual equipment (-19.4% vs -14.6%), cars (-8.3% vs -6.6%), building materials (-17.0% vs -8.3%), and petroleum products (-8.0% vs -5.9%).

China's surveyed urban unemployment rate stood at 5.1% in November 2025, unchanged from the previous month and in line with market expectations. The latest figure remained at its lowest level since June. Among the locally registered labor force, the unemployment rate was unchanged at 5.3%, while the rate for the migrant labor force also remained steady at 4.7%. Within the migrant workforce, those holding agricultural household registration recorded an unemployment rate of 4.4%. Across 31 major cities, the surveyed urban unemployment rate likewise held steady at 5.1%. Meanwhile, enterprise employees nationwide worked an average of 48.6 hours per week. Over the first eleven months of the year, the national surveyed urban unemployment rate averaged 5.2%.




