

#### MARKET COMMENTARY

So far NonFarm Payrolls and inflation have become useless and the Fed is being forced to guess on data. Japanese rate hike has played out but markets are expecting more. The Japanese carry trade is going to remain under pressure. We had our option expiry play but it's going to be big in the US tonight. CNBC – US Inflation Fudge > Thursday saw the release of a much lighter-than-expected consumer price report for November, breaking from the recent trend of sticky inflation. The Bureau of Labor Statistics reported that the consumer price index had an annual inflation rate of 2.7% last month, while core CPI – a measure that excludes volatile food and energy prices – was even lower at 2.6%. Both were below than what economists had been estimating, as those polled by Dow Jones called for an annual headline rate of 3.1% and a rate on core CPI of 3%. The November data release Thursday was delayed by 8 days because of the U.S. government shutdown, but more importantly, the October data was canceled, leaving it to the BLS to make certain methodological assumptions about the prior months' inflation levels. Those assumptions in the methodology were not clear to economists and were not fully explained in the release. "The downside surprise reflects weakness in both goods and services, but may be partly due to methodological issues. The BLS might have carried forward prices in some categories, effectively assuming 0% inflation," Michael Gapen, chief U.S. economist at Morgan Stanley, said in a note, deeming the November reading as "noisy" in a way that's "difficult to draw strong conclusions." "If these technical factors are the main source of weakness, we could see reacceleration in December," Gapen added. Economists were zooming in on one particularly important subset in the data as problematic: owners' equivalent rent. This is a key part of calculating the inflation seen in the housing market. UBS economist Alan Detmeister said the price changes in October for the OER appear to have been "set to zero." Evercore ISI's Krishna Guha, digging deeper, said it appears the BLS "put in zero inflation in multiple categories" while calculating the OER for the approximately one-third of cities used. "To the extent that it introduces a downward bias, the Fed would be mindful of the risk of taking the data on housing services inflation at face value," he wrote in a Thursday note. Detmeister said the impact of this could linger for the next few months.

The Bank of Japan unanimously raised its key short-term interest rate by 25bps to 0.75% at its December meeting, marking the highest level since September 1995 and aligning with market expectations. The move marked the central bank's second rate hike this year, following a similar increase in January, underscoring a gradual shift away from its ultra-loose policy stance. The BoJ said it expects companies to continue delivering steady wage increases in 2026, amid improving corporate profits. Even so, the board stressed that real interest rates remain "significantly negative" and that overall financial conditions are still broadly accommodative to ensure continued support for economic activity. Policymakers reiterated that if the outlook presented in October materializes, the board will continue to lift borrowing costs. The BoJ projected that core consumer price inflation will slow to below its 2% annual target through the first half of FY 2026, before gradually picking up thereafter.

Japan's core consumer price index, which excludes fresh food but includes energy, rose 3% year-on-year in November 2025, unchanged from October and in line with market expectations. The reading remains well above the Bank of Japan's 2% target, reinforcing the case for a near-term interest rate hike. The central bank is widely expected to raise its policy rate by 25 basis points to 0.75% on Friday to curb inflation, with markets pricing in a further increase toward 1% by July next year. However, the outlook has been complicated by a downward revision to third-quarter GDP, which indicated a sharper contraction than previously estimated. Adding to the policy debate, Prime Minister Sanae Takaichi, a proponent of looser monetary policy, reportedly told a business lobby on Wednesday that Japan should prioritize proactive fiscal spending rather than excessive tightening to support growth and bolster tax revenues.


The Bank of Mexico cut its benchmark interest rate by 25bps to 7% in its December meeting, as expected, bringing it to its lowest level since May 2022. This marks the twelfth consecutive rate cut in an easing cycle that began in March last year, aimed at stimulating economic growth amid sluggish GDP performance and uncertainty over US tariffs. Mexico's GDP shrank 0.2% in Q3 after stagnating in Q2, prompting Banxico to halve its 2025 growth forecast to 0.3%, though it expects 1.1% in 2026 and 2% in 2027. The decision was split, with Deputy Governor Jonathan Heath voting to hold, reflecting concerns over persistent inflation. Headline inflation rose to 3.8% in November, slightly above expectations, while core inflation, excluding volatile items, remains stubbornly above 4%. Despite near-term inflation risks, Banxico projects inflation will return to its 3% target by Q3 2026.

The annual inflation rate in the US came in at 2.7% in December 2025, the lowest since July, below forecast of 3.1% and 3% reported for September. The energy index increased 4.2%, with gasoline rising 0.9%, fuel oil soaring 11.3% and natural gas gaining 9.1%. Also, food prices rose 2.6%, shelter cost was up 3% and other notable increases were recorded for medical care (2.9%), household furnishings and operations (4.6%), recreation (1.8%), and used cars and trucks (3.6%). The lowest price increases were recorded for apparel (0.2%) and new vehicles (0.6%). Meanwhile, annual core inflation came in at 2.6%, the lowest since March 2021, compared to forecasts of 3%. The BLS did not collect data for October 2025 due to the 43-day government shutdown. As a result, October figures were missing, and November monthly data were not released. However, the BLS said that the CPI increased 0.2% over the 2 months from September to November 2025.

Housing Credit in Australia remained unchanged at 0.60 percent in November 2025, the same pace as in the previous three months. Housing Credit in Australia averaged 0.90 percent from 1976 until 2025, reaching an all time high of 3 percent in April of 1980 and a record low of -0.40 percent in July of 1984. Australia's private sector credit rose 0.6% month-on-month in November 2025, surpassing market expectations of a 0.2% growth but easing from a 0.7% increase in the previous month. Credit growth moderated for business lending (0.7% vs 0.8% in October), while housing remained steady at 0.6%, and personal credit fell 0.5% after edging up 0.1% in October. On an annual basis, private credit increased by 7.4%, accelerating slightly from a 7.3% gain in the prior month, marking the fastest expansion since January 2023.

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
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
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#### 1. Movers and Shakers in S&P 300 >
