



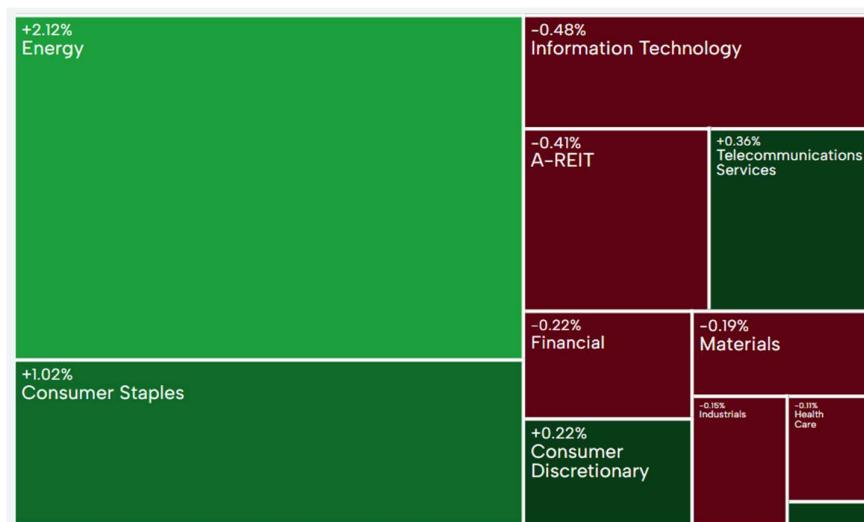
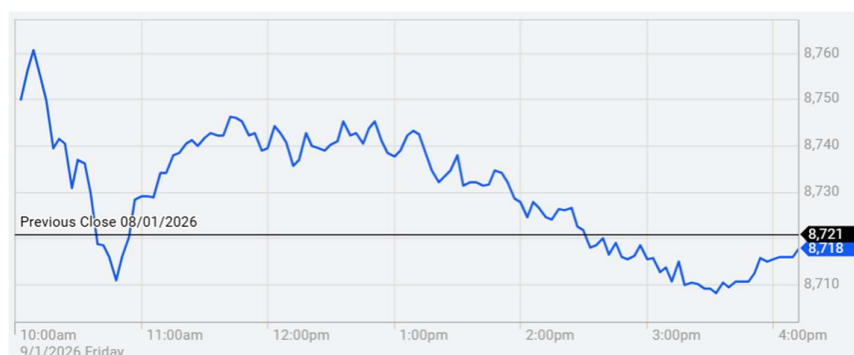

MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market had another flat day on low turnover as markets are waiting for the next episode of “What Will Trump Do Next?”. It is a reality TV except with massive consequences. The social unrest coming from random policy and lies are starting to cost lives. Most of the world does not want to call out the lies because they are trying to avoid the attention of the Whitehouse but that has left the US economy in a mess as vested interest groups are running free for all grifting at all levels. The Venezuela attack has gone from liberating the people to straight out resource theft. The ICE shooting has fueled a divided country into more social mess. Supreme court decision tonight on tariffs could attract another random attack after Whitehouse has threatened number of countries in the recent week. Everything has a cost and US economy is paying for all the policy failures. The tariff policy was based on a lie that other countries pay it. If the court rules it illegal, there is no real way for it to be unwound. It will likely benefit the importers who will take the return and keep it. Whitehouse is likely to then change the tariff into sector tariffs. This means we have even more costs to process and collect it. Either way, the economy is taking hits and middle to low income are under the pump. Just about anything could happen over the weekend. It may be different this time!

CNBC – US Tariffs > The U.S. Supreme Court on Friday could rule on the legality of President Donald Trump’s tariffs, a decision poised to have far-reaching impacts on not only trade policy, but also the U.S. fiscal situation. Though it’s not certain that the high court will make its ruling, it has scheduled Friday as a “decision day” for handing down opinions, and there is widespread speculation that the tariff case will come up. At its core, the ruling will address two issues: whether the administration can use provisions under the International Emergency Economic Powers Act to levy the tariffs, and if it isn’t proper, if the U.S. will have to reimburse those importers who already have paid the duties. However, the final decision could also fall somewhere in between. The court has the option to grant limited powers under the IEEPA and require only limited repayment, along with multiple other options for how it handles a touchy matter that is being closely watched on Wall Street. Moreover, even should the White House lose the case, it has other tools in its chest to implement tariffs that don’t require the emergency powers cited under the act. Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent himself said Thursday he expects a “mishmash” ruling. “What is not in doubt is our ability to continue collecting tariffs at roughly the same level, in terms of overall revenues,” Bessent said during an appearance in Minneapolis. “What is in doubt, and it’s a real shame for the American people, was the president loses flexibility to use tariffs both for national security, for negotiating leverage.” Trump used the IEEPA in part as an emergency measure to stop the inflow of fentanyl to the U.S. Administration officials have cited a number of options to offset the court’s decision should it not go their way. Prediction markets site Kalshi is pointing to just a 28% probability that the court will rule in favor of the tariffs as implemented.

Historically, 75% of retail investors have experienced losses during positive market periods. Investors are now facing market cycles that are unprecedented in their lifetime, making risk management a crucial aspect of investing. Going forward, the trend towards active investing is reemerging as investors seek quality, relative value, profitability, and dividends. Indonesia's consumer confidence declined slightly to 123.5 in December 2025, down from 124.0 in November, which was the highest level in nine months. The decrease came as most of the six main sub-indices deteriorated, with views of current income levels dropping 1.3 points to 120.2, while the economic outlook fell 1 point to 135.6 and perceptions of current economic conditions edged down 0.1 points to 111.4. At the same time, the index for purchasing durable goods compared to six months ago declined 1.8 points to 107.6. Expectations for job availability over the next six months also decreased, down 0.2 points to 135.1. Meanwhile, job availability compared to six months ago rose 2.8 points to 106.5, and income expectations for the next six months increased by 0.2 points to 140.8.

Median one-year-ahead inflation expectations in the US rose to 3.4% in December 2025, up from 3.2% in each of the previous two months, according to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York's Survey of Consumer Expectations. In contrast, three- and five-year inflation expectations were unchanged at 3.0%, suggesting stable longer-term inflation views. Inflation uncertainty increased across all horizons, indicating growing dispersion in expectations about future price outcomes. Meanwhile, median year-ahead price expectations declined across major household categories, including gas, food, medical care, college education, and rent. The survey also pointed to softening labor market sentiment, with job-finding expectations falling to a series low, the second such low in six months, while job-loss expectations worsened. Expectations for household income growth and spending, however, remained largely unchanged.

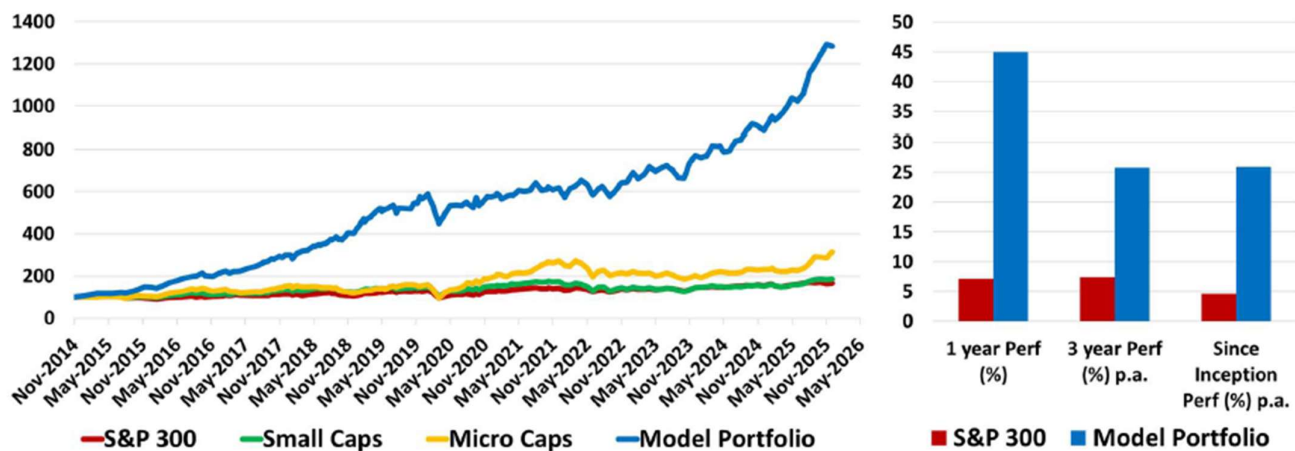
Japan's leading economic index, which gauges the outlook for the coming months based on indicators such as job offers and consumer sentiment, increased to 110.5 in November 2025 from 109.8 in October and came in above market forecasts of 110.4. The latest reading marked the highest level since May 2024, supported by consumer confidence, which rose to its highest level in 18 months in November. Employment reached a fresh record high, despite the unemployment rate remaining steady at 2.6%. Meanwhile, cost pressures are expected to persist heading into year-end. However, overall consumption remains in a recovery phase.

China's producer prices fell 1.9% year-on-year in December 2025, easing from a 2.2% decline in November and extending the contraction to a 39th consecutive month. The latest reading was slightly above market expectations of a 2.0% drop, marking the mildest decline since August 2024, reflecting Beijing's continued efforts to rein in excessive price competition. Consumer goods prices dropped a bit slower (-1.3% vs -1.5% in November), driven by milder falls in durable goods (-3.5% vs -3.6%) and clothing (-0.1% vs -0.3%), while food prices remained weak (-1.5% vs -1.5%). In contrast, costs of daily-use goods rose slightly faster (1.4% vs 1.1%). At the same time, production material prices fell more slowly (-2.1% vs -2.4%), with decreases softening in mining (-4.7% vs -6.1%), raw materials (-2.6% vs -2.9%), and processing (-1.6% vs -1.9%). For the full year of 2025, producer prices shrank 2.6%. Monthly, the PPI rose 0.2% in December, after edging up 0.1% in the previous two months.

China's annual inflation rate edged higher to 0.8% in December 2025 from 0.7% in the prior month, marking the highest level since February 2023 but falling short of market forecasts for 0.9%. The latest result also pointed to the third straight month of consumer inflation, with food prices rising the most in 14 months (1.1% vs 0.2% in November), driven by sharper price increases in fresh vegetables and fresh fruit. Meanwhile, non-food inflation remained steady (at 0.8%), helped by ongoing consumer trade-in programs. Prices continued to rise for clothing (1.7% vs 1.9%), healthcare (1.8% vs 1.6%), and education (0.9% vs 0.8%). In contrast, housing prices fell 0.2% after being flat previously, while transport costs dropped further (-2.6% vs -2.3%). Core inflation, which excludes food and energy, held at 1.2% yoy, staying at its highest in 20 months. Monthly, the CPI rose 0.2%, after a 0.1% drop in November. For the whole year, inflation was flat, below the official target of around 2%.

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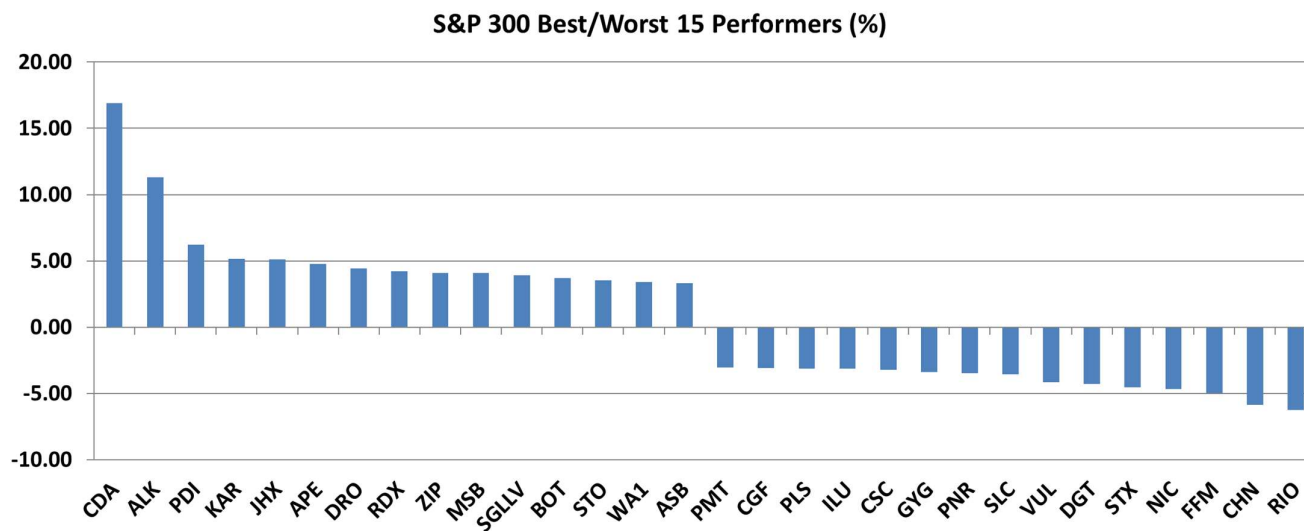
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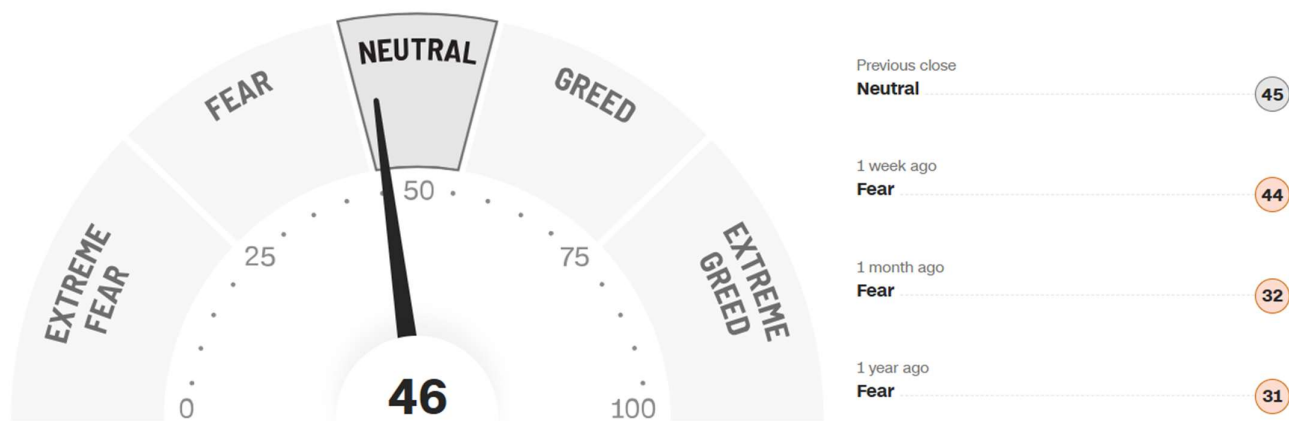
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1. Movers and Shakers in S&P 300 >
