

MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market had a positive day to finish the week with global flow continuing to dominate. Yesterday rotation from banks to miners and that reversed today. Banks are going up despite fundamentals getting worse. US TACO'd (Trump Always Chickens Out) Iran attack after Iran supposedly told them they won't do killings. CNBC – India > India's exports to China soared in December while shipments to the U.S. declined as President Donald Trump's steep tariffs prompt New Delhi to focus on alternative markets. Exports to China surged 67% in December to \$2 billion, in contrast to goods shipped to the U.S. — New Delhi's biggest export market — that dropped 1.8% to \$6.8 billion, according to government data released late Thursday. The U.S. has slapped 50% tariffs on New Delhi, among the highest on any country and even more than on China, upending both the trade and diplomatic relations between the two countries. During the first nine months of the fiscal year ending March 2026, India's exports to mainland China have risen nearly 37%, while shipments to Hong Kong have jumped more than 25%. Earlier this week, India's Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri met Vice Minister of the International Department of the Communist Party of China Sun Haiyan in New Delhi to discuss the "progress made in stabilizing and rebuilding bilateral ties with priority on business and people-centric engagements."

CNBC – Japan > Some Bank of Japan policymakers see scope to raise interest rates sooner than markets expect, with April a distinct possibility, as a sliding yen risks adding to already broadening inflationary pressure, four sources familiar with its thinking said. BOJ policymakers are facing the unenviable task of pushing up years of ultra-low borrowing costs even as rising global headwinds weigh on growth in an economy that has only recently started to shake off the effects of chronic deflation. Having just raised interest rates to a 30-year high of 0.75% in Dec., the central bank is set to keep borrowing costs steady at its two-day policy meeting ending on Jan. 23. But many BOJ policymakers see scope for further rate hikes with some not ruling out the chance of action in April, the sources said, which would be earlier than dominant private-sector views centered on monetary tightening occurring in the second half of this year.

The Eurozone's trade surplus narrowed to €9.9 billion in November 2025 from €15.4 billion a year earlier, below market expectations of €15.2 billion, as exports fell 3.4% while imports decreased 1.3%. In the broader EU, the trade surplus also fell to €8.1 billion from €11.8 billion. EU exports dropped 4.4% to €213.8 billion, due to lower sales of machinery & vehicles (-1.3%), chemicals (-12.8%), and food & drink (-1.6%). Exports decreased to the US (-20.3%), the UK (-6%) and China (-1.2%), but rose to Switzerland (6.7%). Meanwhile, imports fell 2.9% to €205.7 billion, mainly due to lower purchases of energy (-22.5%) and chemicals (-4.6%). On the other hand, imports rose for machinery & vehicles (3.3%). Imports from key partners fell, including the US (-7.1%), the UK (-4.7%), and Switzerland (-1.9%). However, imports from China rose 3.8%.

Eurozone industrial production increased by 0.7% month-on-month in November 2025, matching October's pace and exceeding market expectations of 0.5% growth. Capital goods output surged 2.8%, up from 0.5% in the previous month, while intermediate goods growth slowed to 0.3% from 0.9%. Production fell in energy (-2.2% vs 1.3%), durable consumer goods (-1.3% vs 2.4%), and non-durable consumer goods (-0.6% vs -0.4%). On an annual basis, industrial production expanded 2.5%, up from 1.7%, marking the largest year-on-year increase since May and surpassing forecasts of 2.0%.


Initial jobless claims in the US fell by 9,000 from the previous week to 198,000 on the week ending January 10th, contrasting with market expectations of an increase to 215,000, to mark the second-lowest reading in two years. In the meantime, continuing claims fell to 19,000 to 1,884,000 at the turn of the year, in line with market expectations, to extend the decreasing trend since October, albeit remaining above averages since 2022. The result continued to reflect a labor market that has low firing and relatively low hiring. In the meantime, initial unemployment claims from federal employees, which have been under scrutiny as markets measure the impact of the US government shutdown, rose by 170 to 646.

The Philadelphia Fed Manufacturing Index surged 21.4 points to 12.6 in January 2026, marking its highest level since September, as activity rebounded sharply from an upwardly revised -8.8 in December and far exceeded market expectations of -2. New orders rose to 14.4 and shipments increased to 9.5, signaling improved demand and deliveries, while inventories fell to -8.4, the lowest since July 2024. Employment remained positive at 9.7, though slightly lower than last month, and the average workweek edged down to 9.1. Input prices eased slightly, with the prices paid index dipping to 46.9, while the prices received index rose to 27.8, indicating ongoing cost pressures. Looking ahead, the future activity index slipped to 25.5, with future new orders falling to 32.9 and future shipments rising to 40.8. Firms continue to anticipate modest growth in employment and elevated prices over the next six months, reflecting cautious optimism amid sustained price pressures.

The NY Empire State Manufacturing Index in the US jumped to 7.7 in January 2026 from a revised -3.7 in December, beating forecasts of 1. The reading showed business activity in New York state rose modestly, as new orders increased (6.6 vs -1), and shipments grew at a solid pace (16.3 vs -5). Delivery times were unchanged (0.0 vs -5.9) and inventories edged down (-2.1 vs 4), while supply availability worsened slightly (-4.1 vs -6.9). Employment (-9 vs -7.5) and the average workweek (-5.4 vs 2.5) both declined after increasing over the prior two months. The pace of input price increases was little changed and remained elevated (42.8 vs 44.2), while the pace of selling price increases slowed to its lowest pace in nearly a year (14.4 vs 25.4). Meanwhile, capital spending plans grew modestly for a third consecutive month (10.3 vs 6.9) and firms remained fairly optimistic about the outlook, with half expecting conditions to improve over the next six months.


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1. Movers and Shakers in S&P 300 >
