
MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market had a mainly flat day after starting negatively. Global passive flow into the banks pushed the market out of the negative start. Like US market being held up by overvalued tech, local market is being held up by overvalued banks. It is all about global mega passive flow. In low turnover days, it's more obvious to see. US is getting beaten up on the media about their fake Greenland deal and the shockingly low quality members in the "Board of Peace" groups. If there was any irony in the name of that board, it was surpassed by Jared Kushner's presentation to rebuild genocide land as "master plan". Canadian PM's speech to move past US has hit a nerve. US is sending a lot of ships to Middle East before the government shut-down starts in Feb. If the domestic politics gets worse and Epstein file demands get louder, US may attack Iran for distraction. Given the social media posts to distract the public, it would not be a real surprise to anyone. Japan is going to election as fiscal handouts make the ponzi worse. It may be different this time!

CNBC – US and Greenland > When something is phrased as a "framework" or "concept" of a deal, and described as "a little bit complex" without additional details, it's not surprising that things can get lost in translation. While Denmark on Thursday signaled it was open to talks with the U.S. over its "Golden Dome" missile defense plan, which is part of the "deal" regarding Greenland that U.S. President Donald Trump announced a day earlier, Greenland's Prime Minister Jens-Frederik Nielsen said that he doesn't know what's in the agreement. Broader reaction by analysts and political watchers reflected a mix of relief and confusion. Ed Price, senior non-resident fellow at New York University, told CNBC on Thursday that striking a deal "requires two people to tango," describing Trump's speech at the World Economic Forum in Davos, Switzerland, as "a monologue not a dialogue." But Trump walking back on his tariff threats on EU countries and toning down the rhetoric on Greenland has lifted markets globally, reviving talks of TACO — "Trump Always Chickens Out" — trade.

CNBC – South Korea > Japan's central bank on Friday raised economic growth forecasts while holding its key policy rate at 0.75% as the country prepares to go into an election. The Bank of Japan upgraded its economic growth forecast for the fiscal year ending in March 2026 to 0.9% from 0.7% in October 2025, and also raised its GDP expansion outlook for the 2026 fiscal year to 1% from 0.7%. The central bank expects Japan's GDP to grow moderately as other countries return to growth, and the BOJ sees a virtuous cycle of rising prices and wages, supported by government's economic measures and accommodative financial conditions. The central bank kept the benchmark interest rate steady in a split 8-1 decision, after raising it to the highest level in 30 years in December, ahead of snap polls that could see Prime Minister Sanae Takaichi sharpen her advocacy for monetary easing and fiscal support.

The US economy expanded at an annualized rate of 4.4% in Q3 2025, slightly above the initial estimate of 4.3% and marking the strongest GDP growth since Q3 2023. The upward revision primarily reflected stronger exports and a smaller drag from inventories. Robust growth was driven by firm consumer spending, a rebound in exports, and higher government outlays. Consumer spending rose 3.5%, unchanged from the initial estimate and the fastest pace this year, accelerating from 2.5% in Q2. Exports surged 9.6%, revised up from 8.8% and rebounding from a 1.8% decline in the prior quarter while imports fell 4.4%, extending the decline seen in Q2. Government spending recovered (2.2% vs -0.1%), while the drag from private inventories eased significantly, subtracting just 0.12 percentage points from growth compared with 3.44 percentage points in Q2. Meanwhile, fixed investment increased 0.8%, below the initial estimate of 1% and slowing sharply from 4.4% in Q2.

The S&P Global Japan Manufacturing PMI climbed to 51.5 in January 2026, above both the final reading of December 2025 and market forecasts of 50, preliminary estimates showed. This marked the first expansion in factory activity since last June, albeit a modest one, supported by the first upturn in sales since May 2023, with foreign sales increasing for the first time in nearly four years. Meanwhile, in response to greater capacity and the first upturn in outstanding business in three-and-a-half years, firms raised employment at the fastest pace since April 2019. On the price front, both input and output cost inflation accelerated. Looking ahead, business sentiment weakened amid uncertainty over global economic conditions.


Japan's S&P Global Services PMI rose to 53.4 in January 2026 from 51.6 in the previous month, marking the highest reading since July, flash data showed. The latest result also signaled a tenth consecutive month of expansion in services activity, with new orders growing at the fastest pace in four months and overseas demand continuing to strengthen. Also, employment increased at a solid pace, supported by a notable rise in outstanding business at services firms. On the pricing front, cost pressures eased as input price inflation softened, though companies continued to raise their selling prices at a faster rate.

Singapore's annual inflation rate stood at 1.2% in December 2025, unchanged from the previous two months and in line with market expectations. Prices were stable for food (1.2%), housing and utilities (0.2%), and information and communications (-2%). Additionally, costs rose slightly for transport (3.6% vs 3.2%) and education (1.2% vs 1.1%). On the other hand, deflation deepened for clothing and footwear (-1% vs -0.5%), while it slipped for household durables and services (-0.3% vs 0%) and ticked down for recreation, sport and culture (0.3% vs 0.5%) and miscellaneous goods and services (0.1% vs 0.2%). On a monthly basis, consumer prices edged up to 0.3% from 0.2% in November 2025. Meanwhile, the annual core inflation rate remained unchanged at 1.2% in December, the same as in the previous two months.

The Bank of Japan kept its key short-term interest rate unchanged at 0.75% at its first policy meeting of 2026, maintaining borrowing costs at their highest level since September 1995, ahead of February's snap election. The widely expected decision was backed by an 8–1 vote, with board member Hajime Takata calling for a hike while others viewed risks to the economic and price outlook as broadly balanced. Policymakers reiterated that rates could rise further, following two hikes in 2025, if activity and inflation evolve in line with projections. In its quarterly outlook, the board raised its FY 2025 GDP growth to 0.9% from 0.7%, citing support from a recent trade deal with Washington and Tokyo's large stimulus package, which includes subsidies for electricity and gas bills, expanded local government grants, and higher defense spending. The FY 2026 GDP forecast was also lifted to 1.0% from 0.7%, while the core consumer inflation outlook for FY 2026 was nudged up to 1.9% from 1.8%.




