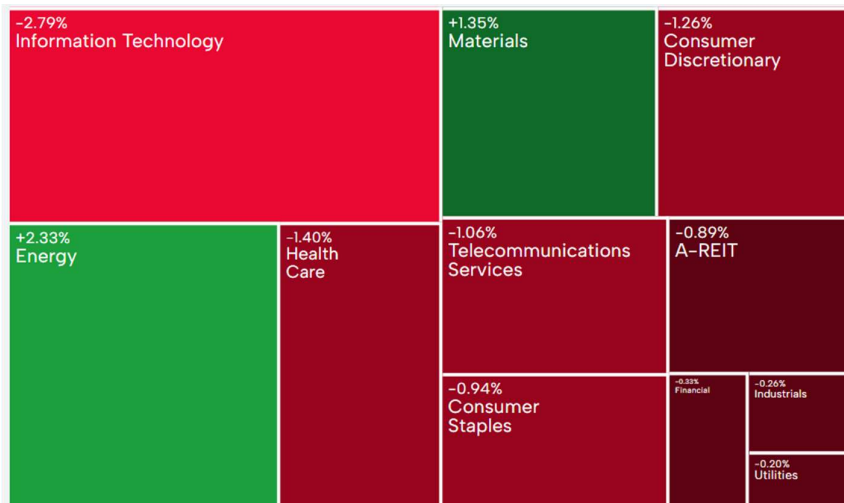
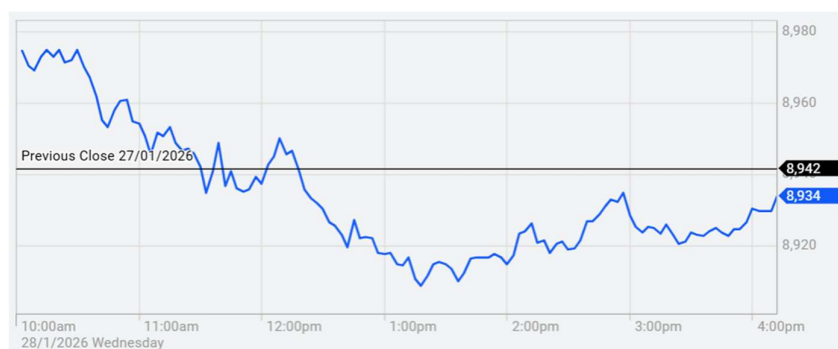
MARKET COMMENTARY

The Aussie market started positively and fell into negative territory after inflation data before recovering to close slightly negative. Global mega passive funds are defending US market while losing returns. The collapsing USD means they are pumping mega techs despite being an underperforming investment. US underperformed the global markets in 2025 and is likely to do that again in 2026. White House reality show continues. India's free trade deal with EU has confirmed Canadian PM's call at Davos. The domestic and global political failures in the US is going to force White House towards an attack on Iran to distract. Locally the inflation came in extremely hot and hit the highest level since Dec 2023. Gold is flying and USD is tanking. US inflation is going to take off. US Fed update tonight will further fuel the attacks from White House. Expect the Fed to do a hawkish hold and White House to lose their mind. It may be different this time!

CNBC – Trade Deals > On Tuesday, India and the European Union announced a “landmark” free trade deal that would remove or reduce tariffs on more than 90% of goods traded between them. The deal, nearly two decades in the making, will see India lower tariffs in two of its most politically sensitive sectors, agriculture and autos. It also lands amid a growing wave of bilateral trade agreements, as countries recalibrate supply chains and commercial ties in response to Washington's increasingly muscular use of tariffs. That broader shift is already visible. Earlier this month, Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney visited China, the first leader in his role to do so in 17 years, in a bid to expand economic partnerships with the world's second-largest economy. UK Prime Minister Keir Starmer is set to follow with a three-day trip to China, the first by a British prime minister since 2018. Still, the India-EU pact, memorably dubbed the “mother of all deals” by European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen, has yet to clear its most unpredictable hurdle: U.S. President Donald Trump. Trump, who has slapped punitive tariffs on friends and foes alike, has yet to weigh in on the India-EU agreement. His silence is notable.

CNBC – China and AI > Chinese companies are accelerating the rollout of new artificial intelligence models as competition with U.S.-based rivals OpenAI, Anthropic and Google intensifies. Just over a year ago, China-made DeepSeek rocked global markets with the release of an AI chatbot that undercut OpenAI's ChatGPT on usage fees and production costs, raising questions about the efficacy of U.S. tech restrictions on China. On Tuesday, Beijing-based startup Moonshot AI revealed Kimi K2.5, which claimed to have video-generation and agentic capabilities that outperformed all three of the leading U.S. AI models. Agentic AI broadly refers to AI systems capable of carrying out tasks on behalf of people. The ultimate goal is to have sophisticated agents that work autonomously with minimal user interaction. The update came just about three months after Moonshot released its K2 model.

Historically, 75% of retail investors have experienced losses during positive market periods. Investors are now facing market cycles that are unprecedented in their lifetime, making risk management a crucial aspect of investing. Going forward, the trend towards active investing is reemerging as investors seek quality, relative value, profitability, and dividends. Germany's GfK Consumer Climate Indicator rose to -24.1 heading into February 2026 from a near two-year low of -26.9 in the prior period, topping market forecasts of -25.8. The improvement was driven by a sharp recovery in income expectations (5.1 vs -6.9 in January), signaling easing pressure on household finances. Economic expectations also strengthened (6.6 vs 1.2), pointing to a more optimistic outlook. Willingness to buy improved as inflation concerns eased (-4.0 vs -7.5), while the propensity to save slipped from its highest level since mid-2008 (17.9 vs 18.7). "With the current increase, the consumer climate has recovered a significant portion of the strong losses from the previous month. However, the level remains low," said Rolf Buerkl, head of consumer climate at NIM. He cautioned that the upturn remains fragile amid geopolitical tensions and uncertain trade conditions, adding that it is unclear whether the positive trend can be sustained in the coming months.

The Case-Shiller 20-City Home Price Index rose 1.4% year over year in November 2025, slightly above October's 1.3% gain and market expectations of 1.2%. While marking the first pickup in ten months, growth remains near a more than two-year low, underscoring a slower US housing market. Home price appreciation continued to lag consumer inflation, which eased to 2.7% in November. As a result, real home values effectively declined over the past year, with price growth trailing inflation by roughly 1.3 percentage points. Chicago led major markets for a second straight month with a 5.7% annual gain, followed by New York at 5.0% and Cleveland at 3.4%. In contrast, Tampa posted the steepest decline, down 3.9% and marking its 13th consecutive month of falling annual prices. Other former pandemic boom markets, particularly in the Sun Belt, also recorded notable declines, led by Phoenix (-1.4%), Dallas (-1.4%), and Miami (-1.0%).

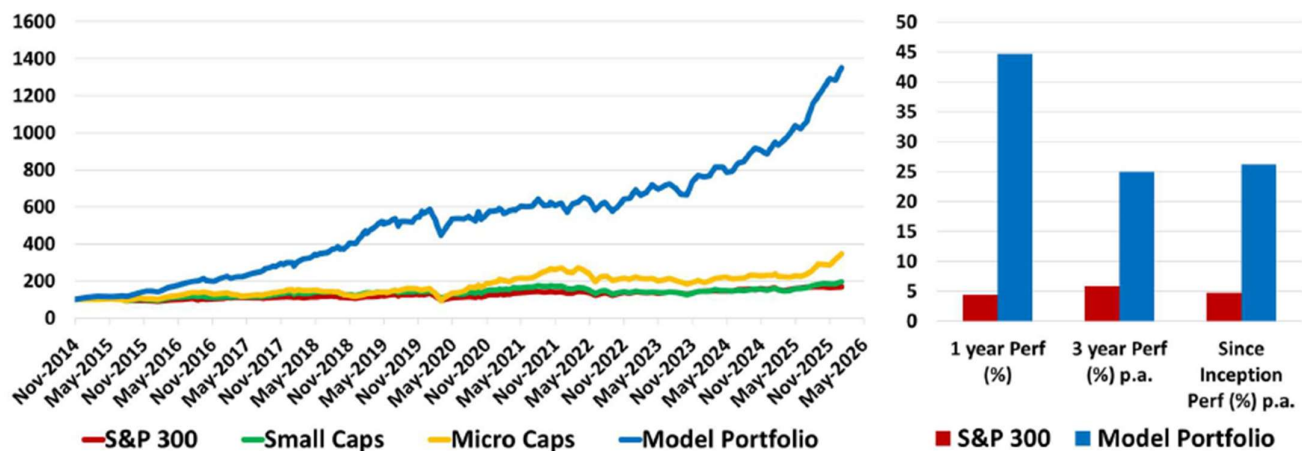
The general business activity index published by the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas rose to 2.7 in January of 2026 from the downwardly revised -5 in the earlier month, reflecting the first improvement in business activity since August. The index measuring revenues jumped to 7.8, gaining traction from the stall in the final month of last year. Consistently, employment levels rebounded (0.9 vs -1.1 in December 2025). On the price front, input costs extended their sharp increases but slowed from the previous month (21.1 vs 27.1), driving companies to ease the growth for selling charges (7.9 vs 8.2). Looking ahead, companies improved their outlook on future business conditions (5.6 vs -2.7).

The Federal Reserve's Fifth District manufacturing index inched higher by one point from the previous month to -6 in January of 2026, the highest in four months, and ahead of the market consensus of a slight decrease to -8. Still, the result reflected an 11th consecutive month of pessimism on the district's goods producing sector. The drop in shipments softened (-5 vs -11 in December 2025) with support from a slower drop in new orders (-6 vs -8) and a faster depletion of backlog of orders (-13 vs -7). In the meantime, employment levels were seen lower (-6 vs -7) and wage growth fell (14 vs 24). Meanwhile, prices paid for inputs rose faster (7.06 vs 6.53), although competition prevented firms from passing those on to clients as output charges slowed (4.58 vs 4.98). Meanwhile, the expectations index for both shipments (34 vs 28) and new order volumes (36 vs 27) improved.

Australia's annual inflation climbed to 3.8% in December 2025 from November's 3-month low of 3.4%, surpassing market forecasts of 3.6% and remaining above the RBA's 2-3% target. Services inflation hit a two-year high (4.1% vs. 3.6% in Q3), driven by year-end holiday travel and accommodation, as well as elevated rents. Meanwhile, goods inflation edged higher (3.4% vs 3.3%), due to a faster rise in electricity cost (21.5% vs 19.7%) as some state rebates expired. Price pressures remained broad-based, with continued increases in food and non-alcoholic drinks (3.4% vs 3.3%), alcohol and tobacco (4.9% vs 4.3%), clothing (3.4% vs 5.1%), furnishings (2.0% vs 1.3%), health (3.6% vs 3.6%), transport (1.6% vs 2.7%), communication (1.1% vs 1.3%), recreation (4.4% vs 3.0%), education (5.4% vs 5.4%), and financial services (2.5% vs 2.5%). The trimmed mean CPI inched up to 3.3% yoy from the prior 3.2%, in line with estimates. Monthly, the CPI rose 1.0%, picking up from a flat print in November.

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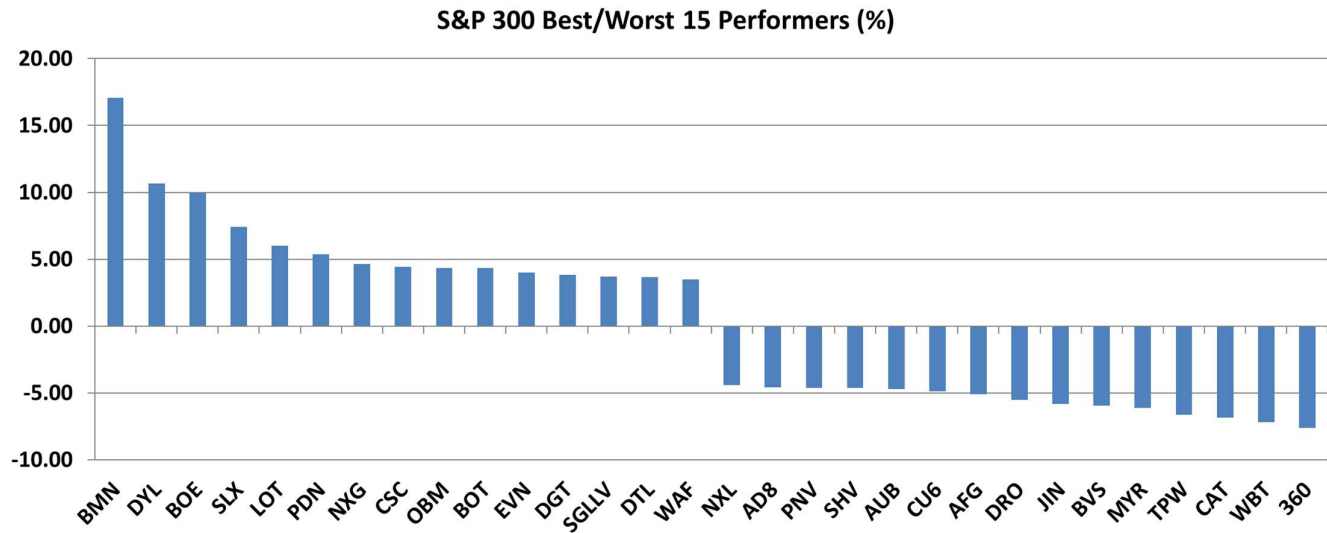
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1. Movers and Shakers in S&P 300 >
